Rules:

- You may apply for more than one scholarship using this single application.
- The criteria for each scholarship vary, but most specify that the recipients must be of high moral and ethical character and in good academic standing.
- It is <u>your</u> responsibility to make all copies of the application and supplemental materials such as essays, letters of recommendation, transcripts or additional applications and submit separate packets for each scholarship to the College & Career Center.
- Easiest way to complete the application is to go to the MBHS website at http://mbhs.slcusd.org, click on Student Resources, then Counseling, then Local Scholarship Application. Fill out the application, then print as many copies for as many scholarships that you're applying to.
- Deadline is March 17, 2014 to be considered an applicant

AAUW (American Association of University Women)

- 1. One for \$1000
- 2. Must be female planning to major in a math- or science-related field in a four-year college/university after high school
- 3. Must write short essay (1 page or less) on topic: "Where I'll be in 5 Years"
- 4. Attach a photo of yourself (not a photo taken with a cell phone)

Aggie Backers/FFA

- 1. Up to \$500 # of winners TBD
- 2. Must be active in FFA and pursuing a degree in agriculture
- 3. Must complete an additional FFA scholarship application
- 4. Must submit 2 letters of recommendation

Atascadero Rotary Club/Shultz Scholarship

- 1. One for \$1,000
- 2. Concentration of study to result in a career in Nursing
- 3. Minimum GPA of 3.5
- 4. Must have participated in extracurricular activities in high school

Bay Osos Filipino Community Association

- 1. One for \$500 (Parents must be members of the Bay Osos Filipino Community Association)
- 2. Must provide a transcript that gives evidence of excellent academic achievement
- 3. Interested students must provide a written (preferably typed) description of their academic achievements and specify the qualifications they meet to be considered for this scholarship

Bay Osos Kiwanis Club

- 1. Three for \$1000 (one for Community Service, two Scholastic Special Achievement)
- 2. Must submit copy of a transcript
- 3. Must have had no disciplinary school suspension and have demonstrated an awareness of community responsibility
- 4. Must submit a typewritten one-page biographical sketch on "Why I Desire to Obtain a College Education"
- 5. Must submit three letters of recommendation; one from a school administrator or counselor; one from a subject-matter teacher; and one from a person not connected with the school

California Retired Teachers Association, Div. #23 Scholarship

- 1. Three for \$1,000
- Must be 2- or 4-year college bound or vocational/technical school bound and must begin college in Fall 2014
- 3. Minimum GPA of 3.5
- 4. Must demonstrate social concern and ability to work with others
- 5. Must submit transcript (Unofficial ok)

California School Employees Association (CSEA)

- 1. One for \$500
- 2. GPA of 3.0 or higher
- 3. Must be planning to continue higher education at a 2-year or 4-year college or vocational/trade school. Funds to be available after proof of enrollment and commencement of classes
- 4. Must write a maximum 250 word essay on: "Why I feel it is important to take the next step in my education/training" OR "What I am expecting/hoping to discover in the next step of my education/training"

Cayucos Garden Club

- 1. One for \$500
- 2. Must be resident of Cayucos

Cayucos Lions-Lioness Club Scholarship

- 1. Number of awards varies from year to year.
- 2. Must be resident of Cayucos
- 3. Must have minimum GPA of 3.0
- 4. Must submit one teacher-written letter of recommendation
- 5. Must submit a short autobiographical essay on where you are from, your goals
- 6. Must be involved in activities or sports
- 7. Finalists will be interviewed at school
- 8. Winners will be invited to attend a joint meeting of the Lions/Lioness Club

Cayucos Rotary

- 1. Two for \$500
- 2. Must be a graduate of Cayucos Middle School
- 3. Must have a minimum GPA of 3.0
- 4. Must be willing to attend a Rotary meeting after the scholarship has been awarded for the purpose of being recognized

Cayucos Senior Citizen Group

- 1. One for \$500
- 2. Must be Cayucos resident
- 3. Must have GPA of 3.0 or higher

C.J. and C.B. Walker Academic Award

- 1. One for \$500, plus a plaque and your name on a perpetual plaque
- 2. Must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher
- 3. Must submit an essay (three paragraphs) in response to the following: How have you been influenced in the development of your plans for the future by a great thinker and achiever such as Newton, Copernicus, Einstein, Shakespeare, Beethoven, Washington, or your parents, a friend or a current teacher?

Community Advisory Committee Scholarship

- 1. One for \$200
- 2. Must be student with an IEP and at least a 2.0 GPA
- 3. Must have good attendance record and a positive attitude
- 4. Include a short description of your goals after high school and how you plan to use the money (college, trade school, job, military, etc.)

Dave and Margaret Wixom Scholarship

- 1. One for \$500
- 2. Must be planning to continue higher education at a 2-year or 4-year college or vocational/trade school pursuing a degree in agriculture or education
- 3. Submit a short typewritten essay on what you have chosen as your major field of study, your long term goals and financial need
- 4. Must submit two letters of recommendation from adults in the school and community

Diana Barnhart Excellence in Science Education Scholarship Endowment

- 1. One for \$1000
- 2. Must be attending Cal Poly SLO pursuing a career as a Science teacher (Agriculture does not count)
- 3. Minimum GPA of 3.0
- 4. Copy of transcript required (unofficial ok)

Dominic Riolo Memorial Scholarship

- 1. One or more awards ranging from \$1000 to \$5000
- 2. Must be majoring in Journalism, Communication Studies, English, Political Science or International Relations.
- 3. **Must pick up the "Supplement for the Dominic Riolo Memorial Scholarship" from the CCC for additional items required**

Dorothy Hammond Scholarship Sponsored by Friends of Los Osos Library

- 1. One for \$1200
- 2. Must have GPA of 2.5 or higher
- 3. Must be resident of Los Osos/Baywood
- 4. Must be planning to continue higher education at a 4-year college, 2-year college, vocational or trade school

Dorothy M. Berry Scholarship

- 1. One for \$500
- 2. Must be planning on studying sculpture or painting at the college level
- 3. Minimum GPA of 3.2

Dr. Harry K. Wolf Scholarship

- 1. Four for \$1000
- 2. Must be majoring in Education or Engineering at Cal Poly
- 3. Must have GPA of 3.0 or higher

Ed Spera Scholarship

- 1. One for \$250
- 2. Must be planning on attending a business, vocational, or trade school (Must NOT be attending a 4year college)
- 3. Must show financial need
- 4. Must complete an essay on how you demonstrate motivation and desire for achievement and opportunity

Estero Bay Women's Club Scholarship

- 1. Two for \$500
- 2. Must be a female
- 3. Must be in good academic standing and have participated in school and/or community activities
- 4. Must write an essay telling who and how a certain person(s) influenced your decision to seek a degree in an intended major or to study at a technical school as an alternative
- 5. Must attach transcript

Estero Bay Women's Club – Ruth Perry Memorial Scholarship

- 1. One (amount undetermined)
- 2. Must be female with special financial difficulties who is making an effort to do her best
- 3. In the Personal Statement section of Part II of the attached application, indicate your special financial needs

Filipino Women's Club of SLO Scholarship

- 1. One for \$200
- 2. Must be of Filipino descent male or female
- 3. Must have 3.0 GPA or higher

Grace Melton Memorial

- 1. One for \$500
- 2. Must be a female
- 3. Must have a 3.0 or higher GPA
- 4. Must be a resident of Estero Bay: Morro Bay, Cayucos, Los Osos
- 5. Must be an American Citizen
- 6. Must submit an essay (two or three paragraphs) in response to the following: "What America Means to Me."

Gregg Evans Scholarship

- 1. One for \$200
- 2. Must be active in FFA and pursuing education in agriculture
- 3. Must have need for financial assistance

Highway One Realty Scholarship

- 1. Two for \$500
- 2. Minimum GPA of 3.0
- 3. Must plan on attending college, vocational school, or military after high school
- 4. Must provide a short statement on future goals

John Bell Memorial Scholarship

- 1. One for \$500
- 2. Must be a male senior with academic and leadership ability
- 3. Interested students must provide a written (preferably typed) description of academic and leadership achievements

John Ruppert Memorial Scholarship

- 1. One for \$100
- 2. Must be currently enrolled in Auto-Industrial Arts and plan future study in that field

King David's Masonic Lodge No. 209

- 1. Three for \$1500
- 2. Must be strong in academics and community service
- 3. ***Must complete the King David Lodge application*** (get from Career Center)

Los Osos Rotary Club

- 1. Multiple awards amounts vary
- 2. Must show ability and desire for training in an academic, technical or vocational field

Los Osos Valley Garden Club

- 1. One for \$500
- 2. Must have financial need for assistance
- 3. Must have initiative in preserving and caring for the environment
- 4. Must have career plans in the field of horticulture or related fields
- 5. Must submit a one-paragraph (typewritten) summary of ways you have protected and made the environment better while in high school and ways your future educational plans contribute to the protection and improvement of our environment

Marguerite B. Ungar Memorial Vocal Arts Scholarship

- 1. One for \$250
- 2. Write a 2-4 paragraph essay in response to: "What does singing mean to you and how do you plan to share your love of vocal music with others?"
- 3. Must have been in choir at least 1 year in high school
- 4. Plans to enroll in some form of post-secondary education
- 5. Likes to sing

Mel Queen Baseball Scholarship

- 1. One for \$500
- 2. Must be attending at 2-4 year college and playing sports
- 3. Must have played a minimum of 2 years of high school baseball
- 4. Must submit a total of 4 recommendation forms 2 from teachers, 2 from coaches (forms in CCC)

Michele Rowley Leary Memorial Scholarship

- 1. One for \$300/with potential for additional and/or higher amount
- 2. All applicants considered, but female preferred
- 3. Prefer that applicants be pursuing a degree in marine biology (or similar study) or a career in the
- fishing industry (vessel captain highly desired)
- 4. Unofficial transcript required
- 5. Write a brief typed essay on the following questions:
 - Describe the greatest obstacle in your life. How did you overcome it?
 - Scholastic or non-scholastic, if you could pick one activity that you enjoy the most, what would it be? Why do you enjoy it so much?
 - Explain why you need financial assistance to attend college.

- 1. One for \$500
- 2. Must be attending a 2 or 4 year college or vocational/trade school

3. Must have strong involvement in community service, agriculture and leadership. Must have minimum GPA of 3.0

Morro Bay Chamber of Commerce

- 1. Two for \$250
- 2. Demonstrate financial need
- 3. Plan to attend Cuesta College and majoring in Business
- 4. Hold a part time job or participate in extra-curricular activities
- 5. Write a brief essay (one page or less) on <u>ONE</u> of the following two questions:
 - Why are you interested in a career in business?
 - What is the role of business in society, or in our community?

Morro Bay Commercial Fishermen's Organization Marine Science

- 1. Three for \$1500
- 2. Must be a conscientious student who has proven his/her capabilities to meet life's challenges by making sensible choices
- 3. Desirable that his/her high school education and experience has included a wide range of diversity
- 4. Provide a typed description of your qualifications, including but not limited to, future educational goals, and why you feel you qualify for one of these scholarships

Morro Bay Eagles

- 1. One up to \$500 for a male (academic or vocational)
- 2. Must have financial need, a satisfactory grade point average, well-balanced against school activities, work schedule and citizenship evaluation
- 3. Submit a short typewritten essay on what you have chosen as your major field of study, your longrange goals, and financial need
- 4. Must submit two letters of recommendation from adults in the school and community

Morro Bay Eagles Ladies Auxiliary

- 1. One up to \$200 for a female
- 2. Must have financial need, a satisfactory grade point average, well-balanced against school activities, work schedule and citizenship evaluation
- 3. Submit a short typewritten essay on what you have chosen as your major field of study, your longrange goals, and financial need
- 4. Must submit two letters of recommendation from adults in the school and community

Morro Bay High School Athletic Boosters

- 1. Four for \$500
- 2. Must have 3.0 cumulative GPA
- 3. Must intend to enroll in a 2-year or 4-year college or trade school
- 4. Must have participated in at least one sport per year of high school

Morro Bay High School Music Boosters

- 1. Two for \$500 (one for choir and one for band)
- 2. Must be planning on involvement with music at the post-secondary level, preferably as a major or minor
- 3. Must submit a one-page essay on "My Plans to Continue with Music Education and Why"

Morro Bay Lions Club

- 1. Two for \$500
- 2. Must have a GPA of 3.5 or higher
- 3. Preference is given to club members and their families
- 4. Must be a resident of Morro Bay

Morro Bay Police Officers' Association

- 3. Minimum GPA of 2.5
- 4. One page written statement on: "Why you deserve this scholarship"

- 2. Submit copy of transcript (unofficial ok)
- 3. Priority will be given to applicants who have a hearing or speech disability, applicants who are interested in pursuing a career in hearing and speck, or who have worked with deaf, hearing, or speech impaired individuals on a volunteer basis, applicants who demonstrate financial need. Please describe your financial need.

Rotary Club of Morro Bay

- 1. Possibly 3-5 awards for \$2000 each
- 2. Must excel in service, leadership, financial need, and academics
- 3. Must provide a written (preferably typed) description of community service, leadership abilities, financial need and academic achievement.
