Scholarships of up to US \$15,000 awarded annually for United Methodist students from Southeast Asia attending United Methodist-related institutions of higher education in the United States

ELIGIBILITY

- Scholarships are awarded to students starting in the Fall semester.
- Students must be comfortable with the English language (TOEFL minimum scores 500 paper or 173 computer for undergraduates; 600 paper or 250 computer for graduates).
- o A grade point average of 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale is required.
- o Students must agree to return to their native countries following graduation.
- o Priority will be given to students from Malaysia, Singapore, and South China, and to students who wish to dedicate their lives to serving humankind in the unselfish manner demonstrated by the Reverend & Mrs. James M. Hoover and Bishop & Mrs. Edwin F. Lee.

DEADLINE

Applications must be received in the office of the United Methodist Higher Education Foundation by March 1.

APPLICATION PROCESS

- Submit this application form, along with:
 - An official transcript of your most recent academic work.
 - A copy of your TOEFL score report.
 - Three (3) letters of recommendation by school headmasters, teachers, professors, pastors, and/or bishops of The Methodist Church.
 - A recent photograph.
