Registration Information

Complete the enclosed registration form and mail with payment to ASCE Student Services. Registrations with payment must be <u>received by December 30, 2008</u> to avoid late registration charges. Registrations <u>received after January 9, 2009</u> will NOT be accepted.

Registration Fees (if received by deadline):

First two advisors	\$50 each*
First four students	\$25 each*
Each additional student	\$150 each*
Each additional advisor	\$150 each*

^{*}Late registration fees are an additional \$50 each if received after the registration deadline.

Hotel Reservations

You must make your own hotel reservations. Mention <u>American Society of Civil Engineers</u> when making your reservations to receive the special conference room rate. The conference rate is \$139+tax/night for single or double occupancy. Reservations made after December 22, 2008, or after the room block has been filled will be accepted on a space available basis only. Special rates cannot be guaranteed if made after the deadline.

Travel Arrangements

Airline reservations should be made at least 21 days in advance of your travel dates to minimize costs. Airline ticket purchases not made at least 21 days in advance may be reimbursed at the 21-day advance purchase rate.

Consider coordinating your travel with others from your ASCE Student Organization or another nearby. All participants are encouraged to travel as inexpensively as possible. Driving is strongly recommended if distance is reasonable.

Reimbursement Policy

Reimbursement of registration, travel and lodging expenses of up to \$500/school has been authorized by CSA for Student Organization representatives, Faculty Advisors and Practitioner Advisors. Participants must attend all sessions in order to be eligible for reimbursement. Only regular registration fees, travel and lodging will be reimbursed; meals, telephone calls, and other incidentals are not eligible for reimbursement. Be advised that each Student Organization will be reimbursed for actual costs incurred up to a maximum of \$500/school. This allotment is intended only to subsidize expenses incurred and may not cover all costs involved in attending the WSCL.

Transportation costs will be reimbursed at the rate of \$0.585/mile for automobile travel. (Note: parking, gas and tolls are included in the \$0.585/mile reimbursement.) Participants within a 50-mile radius are not eligible for travel and housing reimbursements.

Keep all original receipts for airline and hotel room charges; original receipts must be submitted with the official reimbursement request form.

Reimbursement check processing may take up to three weeks after receipt by ASCE Student Services. Please plan accordingly.

Attire

Friday: Business casual (khaki pants & button-down shirt; slacks or skirt with blouse) Saturday: Wear your ASCE Student Organization shirts! Consider bringing extras to exchange with other schools!

ASCE Student Organization Poster Display

Bring a poster describing the ASCE program at your school. Be sure to include vital statistics: university name, size of school, whether it is primarily a commuter or residential school, CE Department size, and ASCE Student Organization size. You may consider: a campus map; a map of the town where the school is located; photos of the CE building, Student Organization activities and representatives; most recent annual report.

ASCE Student Organization Introductory Slide

Prior to the WSCL, your ASCE Student Organization must submit an introductory PowerPoint slide about your ASCE Student Organization. The slide template will be emailed to your Student Organization after your registration is processed. At the WSCL, each Student Organization will be given the opportunity to present its introductory slide to the WSCL participants. Choose one representative from your Student Organization to make the presentation.
