Listed below are the specific requirements you must adhere to for the Humanities Fair 2014. Please ask Mr. Bermudez if you have any questions whatsoever about the following requirements.

- 4 Page Paper (Not Including the cover page, bibliography, and IB reflection pages)
- Font Size=12
- Font type=Times Roman
- Double-spaced type
- Cover Page Required (title, name, date, classroom, picture of topic)
- Bibliography Page Required (minimum of four sources, 2 books and 2 internet sources, textbook NOT included)
- When picking your controversial / social global topic issue, one must provide information/facts/data like a expository paper. Example topics: death penalty, women's rights, cloning, gun control etc.)
- An IB reflection page is required for each paper (what areas of interaction/IB learner profile does this project fall under? Have at least one connection to each of the areas of interaction)
- Your paper needs an introduction, support paragraphs/evidence, and a conclusion. It needs to explain who, what, where, when, why, and how regarding your specific topic.

What your paper should look like when your final draft is turned in:

Page 1: Cover Page

Page 2: Table of Contents

Page 3-7: Written Paper (4 pages, double-spaced) Please include data, facts, statistics. Remember your job is to give out information on your topic

Page 8: Global Perspective 1 Page about the topic (How other people from around the world view about the

topic you discussed)

Page 8: Bibliography Page

Page 9: IB Reflection Page

Page 10: About the Researcher Page (Include a mini-bibliography about yourself and include a self picture)

Poster board- Must be a three-fold poster board covering your topic.

- The students will present their projects using a poster board
- A graph/charts/pictures are required for all poster boards.
- A minimum of 4 illustrations required for all poster boards.
- An IB reflection page should be included on the poster boards.
- The board should reflect relevant information on your topic. Remember to decorate your board & make use of color.
- Power Point-Minimum slides are 7 and must also include elements from the poster board along with animation and sound. (OPTIONAL)
