- 1. The tournament will consist of 3 divisions. The divisions will be as follows: A-Open Division-185 and above, B-Classified Division-184 and below, and C-Handicap Division-155 and under. (Handicap will be based off of 90% of 200) Bowlers may decide to move up a division, but they will not be permitted to move down. This tournament is open to all sanctioned USBC youth bowlers. See Rule No.6 for Average Verification.
- 2. Divisions A and B will bowl 15 games (3-5 game blocks) & division C will bowl 9 games (3-3 game blocks). Each game's lane number will be printed on the recap sheet provided for them. There will be (2) blocks on Saturday November 7, 2015. The first block will begin at 10:00a.m. The second block will begin at 3:30p.m. Sunday's block will begin at 9:00a.m. Following the last block there will be a cut to the top (5) bowlers in each division. Stepladder finals will start immediately after last block. Opening ceremonies will be held at 9:50a.m on Saturday. Check in for all bowlers will be 30 minutes prior to the start of EACH BLOCK!
- 3. The cost for division A and B will be \$80. per bowler (\$30.00 bowling fee, \$10.00 expenses fee, and \$40.00 FSYLA Scholarship Fund) and Division C will be \$50. per bowler (\$18.00 bowling fee, \$7.00 expense fee, and \$25.00 FSYLA Scholarship Fund). Make all Money Orders or Certified Checks Payable to FSYLA. NO PERSONAL OR LEAGUE CHECKS WILL BE ACCEPTED! No refunds will be given (Tournament directors will have the final discretion on all refunds)
- 4. Junior Gold Qualifying will be in compliance with the USBC handbook. Jr. Gold qualifying will be 1:5 (no major fraction thereof. See page 8 of the handbook). Jr. Gold Qualifier Entry will be U20-\$40. U15-\$30. and U12-\$20. Jr. Gold Qualifying Games will be the following: Blocks 1, 2 and 3-Games 2 and 3. In the event of a tie, a 9th/10th frame roll off will determine a winner (based on USBC rule 326A, item 2B). Please note this is not a Primer Tournament!
- **5.** Entries will be processed on a **FIRST COME, FIRST SERVE BASIS**. Entries will be limited to the first 192 received. Walk in entries will be accepted at the bowling center Saturday November 7th starting at 8:00a.m.
- 6. All bowlers must wear suitable attire. No denim, halters, tank tops, spaghetti strap or head apparel (except ear buds) will be allowed. ALL BOWLERS ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR COLLARED SHIRTS (BUTTERFLY COLLARS ONLY!) OR USBC JERSEYS. Shorts, skorts, skirts MUST be no shorter than 3 ½" above the knee max. All pants will be worn at waist level with no underwear or bare skin showing. Holes (torn or purchased) in clothing are not allowed. Youth participants will not wear or use bowling equipment depicting alcohol, tobacco, gambling, and illegal substance or inappropriate language/gestures during competition (rule 301b). The tournament officials will determine proper attire. The tournament director will have the right to ask any bowler to change his/her clothing. If the bowler refuses, he/she will NOT be able to bowl and the entry fee will be forfeited.
- 7. No substance of any kind (dry towels only) may be placed on the score console or ball return. USBC approved ball cleaners can only be used in between games or before the start of a squad.
- 8. All averages must be verified and signed by your league coach or association secretary. The entering average shall be the HIGHEST 14-15 YEARBOOK AVERAGE (Fall and/or Summer). If a bowler does not have a yearbook average, then their highest current average (at minimum of 12 games). If this is not available, the bowler will bowl in the open division. If a bowler has a current league average (minimum of 12 games) and it is 10 pins higher than their Yearbook Average, current average MUST be used (Rule 319a-2). If a bowler's average is from a Sports Bowling League, their sport average will be adjusted in accordance with the chart on page 67 of the Playing Rules Rulebook in Accordance with USBC Rule #205. At all times, the tournament manager reserves the right to re-rate any bowler's average. ALL BOWLERS ARE REQUIRED TO BRING A CURRENT STANDING SHEET!!
- 9. Scholarships will be awarded per division as follows: 1st Place-\$500 Division A and B, Division C 1st Place-\$300 (Additional scholarships may be awarded based on the number of entries). High Female Finisher (not cashing) and High Block per Block (not cashing) Scholarships will be awarded to the highest bowlers on a minimum of one for every ten entries received (1:10). Scholarships will placed in smart account #10492.
- 10. Bowlers will be given a verbal warning and then disqualified for any of the following but are not limited to: A)Kicking and/or hitting any of the following but not limited to ball returns, score consoles, walls, chairs and/or tables. B) Using profanity, obscene/immensely loud gestures (tournament director has final say in what is considered excessive gesturing) and excessive lofting.
- 11. Appeals or protest regarding scores or eligibility must be filed in accordance with USBC rule #329
- 12. Scores will be recorded and initialed by another bowler on your lanes. All bowlers must have their score sheet signed. Each bowler is responsible for the verification of his/her own scores/division. All scores are unofficial until verification
- 13. This tournament is USBC certified and USBC rules will be enforced.
- 14. The tournament director will have final decisions regarding all matters during the tournament.
- 15. All pre-registered entries need to be postmarked by October 31, 2015.
