Since 1896, our ministry of service has supported and empowered America's most vulnerable groups, including at-risk youth, the frail elderly, low-income families, homeless individuals and families, women and children escaping domestic violence, and those seeking affordable housing solutions. Volunteers of America is proud to be part of a network of charitable non-profits that employs 142,000 Coloradans, represents 8% of Colorado's private workforce, and makes up 7% of Colorado's gross domestic product expenditures.

Like many non-profit organizations, Volunteers of America depends upon contributions from generous donors to meet our community's needs. These donations are incentivized through the charitable deduction, which is different from other itemized deductions in that it encourages individuals to selflessly invest in their communities. It is a highly effective tax provision, as the public typically receives three dollars of benefit for every one dollar donated.
