

Samuel Wilson Ware Eagle Scholarship Fund



The scholarship was established in 2008 by the estate of the late Samuel Wilson Ware and offers a general scholarship(s) award towards college expenses for any Eagle Scout who is a high school graduate or graduating senior and resident of Scioto County, Ohio when earning his Eagle rank. An Eagle Scout, Mr. Ware left a legacy to benefit scouts in the hopes of encouraging Eagle Scouts to continue their involvement and leadership in the Scouting program for years to come.

Procedures

The Eagle Scout applying for a scholarship must:

- * Complete the application personally.
- * Enclose only the items requested in the requirements (no additional Biographies, resumes, or supplementary lists of activities should be attached to the applications
- * Answer all questions on the application. ("See attached" is not an acceptable answer
- * Include on each attachment the applicant's name.
- * Submit all attachments with the application form to ensure that all items are available for review at the same time. (The Scholarship Selection Committee cannot assume responsibility for matching items that come in separately.)

FAXES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED FOR CONSIDERATION

- * Be advised that only those applications postmarked after the first Monday of November, but no later than midnight on the last Friday in February will be considered.
- * Be advised that applications become the property of the selection committee and will not be returned to the applicant
- * The Ware Scholarship Committee will meet the third Thursday of March and will, in writing, inform all applicants of its decision within 10 days of this meeting.
- * Applicants understand that submitting this application is in no way a guarantee that a scholarship will be granted.
- *There is no appeal and the decision of the Scholarship Committee is final.

Requirements

All applicants must:

- Have been granted their Eagle Scout rank, or have verified that their application for Eagle Scout rank has been received at the national office.
- Submit applications that are postmarked after the first
 Monday in November, but no later than midnight on the last
 Friday in February and are received by the Ware Scholarship
 Committee within 5 days of the deadline. Use sufficient postage.
- 3 . Be a graduating high school senior or a high school graduate and resident of Scioto County, Ohio.
- Provide a High School transcript showing ACT and/or SAT scores and class ranking, if available. College transcript if applicable.
- Submit three letters of recommendation, one must be from an adult volunteer or professional Scout leader who knows the applicant personally and two that are friends or employers (no family members)
- Have demonstrated leadership ability in Scouting and participated in activities outside of Scouting.

- 7. Submit a "summary" of your Eagle Scout Service Project. (one page or less)
- 8. Provide with the application a personal letter of intent to attend school or proof of acceptance.
- Be willing to allow his name and picture to be used in Recognition of his selection for the scholarship in local Newspapers, Scouting website and newsletter and at his school's Graduation awards event.
- 10. Submit two (2) essays of 250 to 300 words:
 - *Describe your involvement in your Unit since achieving Eagle Scout, how you supported the leadership goals of your unit and the Boy Scouts of America
 - *Why was it important to you to continue your involvement in your unit after earning Eagle Scout? How do you feel continued involvement with Scouting in high school, college and beyond positively impacts our community?
- Attend the Tecumseh Annual Awards Banquet in full Class A uniform.

Samuel Wilson Ware Eagle Scholarship

Scholarships will be available each year in an amount determined in accordance with the Samuel Wilson Ware Eagle Scholarship Selection Committee Guidelines.

- 1. The Samuel Wilson Ware Eagle Scholarship Fund pays all funds directly to your college/university once the Scholarship Committee has received a payment form that you have filled out.
- 2. These funds are for tuition, room, board, and books for as long as you remain a fulltime student during the life of the scholarship.
- 3. Funds are distributed according to your college/university's guidelines. Any variation on these guidelines is between you and the college/university. The Samuel Wilson Ware Eagle Scholarship Fund will not be involved with distribution of funds other than payment to the school.
- 4. The scholarship is limited to use at a college/university that is accredited by recognized accreditation agencies and offers a bachelor's degree or associates degree upon completion of the course of study offered.
