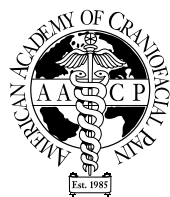

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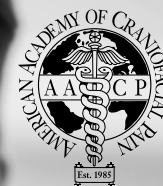

PHASE 2 REHABILITATION OF THE TMD OR NON-TMD PATIENT



As a dentist you are well trained to restore teeth or even place implants in a healthy occlusion; However....

- Fracturing Porcelain
- Gingival Abfractions
- Abnormal Bite Adjustments
- Tooth Mobility
- Fractured Cusps
- Failing Implants or Bone Loss
- Worn Dentition from Clenching/Bruxing
- (Migraine) headaches
- Snoring/Sleep Apnea

Restoring dentitions with implants or crown/bridge to a dysfunctional occlusion and/or airway could be catastrophic to the longevity of restorations and dentition and you possibly could be locking your patient into a pathological condition.
