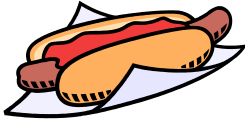

**Ice Cream Social:** The St. John Builders Ice Cream Social is coming up on July 12<sup>th</sup>. This is a wonderful community event that raises money for the ministry of St. John Builders. There are a variety of serving opportunities for you to join in on the fun!

- **PIES:** Everyone knows that ice cream tastes better with pie, so we need a lot of them! Pies of all varieties are needed on the day of the social (Sunday, July 12<sup>th</sup>). Drop off your pie(s) in the Fellowship Hall on Sunday morning or bring them anytime on that day.

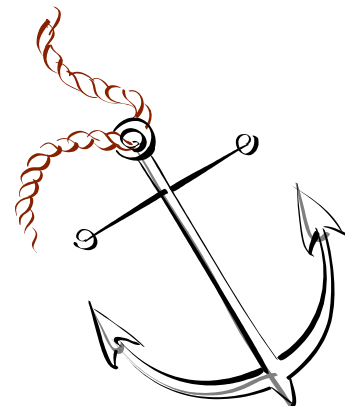

## May 19, 2015

### **Present:**

Pastor Jeff Gramza, David Barrett, Charlene Stephenson, James Hiles, Sandy Kaup, Sue Buxton, Craig Henderson, Dan Heindel, Joe Beiler, Steve Siebert, Andrea Kuehne, Julie Bollenbacher.

**Opening:** Charlene Stephenson opened with devotions and prayer.

**Secretary's Report:** Craig Henderson moved and Charlene Stephenson seconded to accept the secretary's report. Motion passed unanimously.

**Treasurer's Report:** Joe Beiler moved and Sandy Kaup seconded to accept the treasurer's report. Motion passed unanimously.

### **Pastor's report:**

- During the month of April, there were 2 baptisms, 8 confirmed, 1 funeral, and 15 new members. On May 15 & 16, Ed and Lynne Fuelling, and Linda Fisher were our delegates at the North West Ohio Synod Assembly.
- The Youth Summer Events Calendar was finished and mailed. The Mission trip is ready to go with 35 (including 8 adults). Final arrangements for "The Gathering" are underway.
- The Kitefest was a huge success with the largest turn-out to date. 125 kites were flown and 180 dinners were served. Fund raising has started and teams are being organized for the "Relay for Life." The sale of the peacock feathers and t-shirts are off to a great start.
- Thanks to the Gallmans for the hog, the VanTilburgs for roasting it, and St. John Builders for making the ice cream for the Kitefest. Planning is underway for an October trip to Wernle Home.
- Mulch has been delivered and special mulch has been ordered for the children's play areas. We need to get bids for the sealing of the parking lot. Pastor has requested that all cleaning supplies be kept locked up and away from food storage areas.
- We have started the transformation to fewer bulletins, with an announcement page being offered to those who don't need the bulletin.
- April was an excellent month for giving. There was a substantial increase of online giving.
- WOW numbers are not all in yet, but averages of 117 dinners were served. This number has increased every year. Special thanks to the Praise Team for leading the music at the opening for the Elementary and Jr. High kids. VBS and confirmation camp planning are under way.
- Ground was broke on May 9<sup>th</sup> for the latest St. Johns Builders home at 1008 Sycamore St. A "Meal Train" has been started for volunteers to sign up to provide food for the builders.

### **Old Business**

- Pastor Jeff and the council discussed the fact that not much has been said by the congregation about adding a visitation pastor. The executive council will work on it.
- We have not yet received names of local missionaries so we are still contributing to the general missionary fund.



**New Business**

- Pastor Jeff was contacted by Trinity Lutheran Seminary about becoming a financial partner. Discussion followed. On June 14, someone from the seminary will be here to speak at our services. Discussion was held about the possibility of having an intern since the internship program at Trinity has changed.
- There was also discussion about the next phase of the Organ Project and the remodeling of the sanctuary.

**Adjournment:**

Motion to adjourn was made by Joe Beiler, seconded by James Hiles. The Council meeting was closed with the Lord’s Prayer.
