**Poster Presentation Guidelines**

1. Poster Proposals and all accompanying materials must be **electronically submitted** no later than **February 9, 2016**.
2. We consider the Poster Presentations to be an educational activity, and therefore must avoid commercialism and be free of bias. All sources of support must be acknowledged on the Poster.
3. Generic names should be used versus brand names when possible. Also, the use of words such as *novel*, *unique*, *robust*, and *excellent* is thought to be promotional, and **must** be substantiated by proper references or p-values. When possible, use *pharmacologic agent*, *medication*, *therapy*, or a similar term, instead of *drug*.
4. Only Encore presentations from other conferences occurring after April 2016 will be accepted unless new data is being presented.
5. No previously published or presented information will be accepted. All disclaimers regarding publishing or submitting for publication must be disclosed
6. Poster Proposals will be reviewed and selected by members of the Poster Committee. Those selected will be notified at least one month prior to the April 15-17 meeting.
7. Those selected to provide posters for display are responsible for all personal expenses (travel, hotel, etc.). ASIPP will pay for conference fees for the top FIVE presenters. Presenters must be registered for the Meeting on the days Posters will be on display.
9. Posters will be electronically displayed this year. A processing fee of \$50 will be assessed to offset costs of electronic display devices.
10. . Poster Presentations are to be free of commercial bias and avoid proprietary references, including the use of logos. Display posterboard and stands will be provided.
10. Posters will be on display during the meeting on both Friday and Saturday. Presenters will have designated times to be available for questions during these two days.
