GENERAL INFORMATION

The Columbus Symphony Young Musicians Competition provides an opportunity for young musicians in grades 3-12 to perform for professional feedback. Columbus Symphony musicians and collegiate faculty serve as adjudicators. This competition is open to musicians of standard orchestral instruments and piano.

All competitions will be held in performance venues. Participants, family and friends are encouraged to stay and listen to other participants. Warm-up rooms will be available for all participants, including studios with two pianos for Concerto Competition piano participants.

The winner of the Concerto Competition will be the recipient of a \$500 award generously donated by the Columbus Symphony Women's Association.

Performance Requirements

- Performance selections should be of an advanced level (such as OMEA Class A).
 Prepare a movement from a standard work with orchestral accompaniment (performed in both rounds with piano accompaniment).
- Prepare a second solo or movement from a contrasting style period (i.e. Baroque, Classical, Romantic, or 20th century) to be performed at the discretion of the judges if a tie-breaker is needed in the final round.
- Participants MUST provide their own accompanists.
- Memorization is required for primary piece (memorization not required for tie-breaker).
- Two <u>original</u> music scores or parts must be provided for the judges, but you are encouraged to provide additional original scores. Photocopies are not permitted.

SENIOR DIVISION non-competitive (Grades 9-12)

Application fee: \$35

Sat., January 23, 2016, 9 am-1:30 pm

In this division, high school age musicians will perform for Columbus Symphony musicians and collegiate faculty for feedback only. Participants are not required to perform a concerto and no award is given. Participants who earn the highest ratings may be invited to perform for local music clubs as well as part of the Columbus Symphony Orchestra's Young Musicians Showcase. All participants will receive award certificates and comment sheets from the judges.

Performance Requirements

- Prepare a solo piece from a standard work or etude (such as OMEA Class A or B; upper level Guild or OFMC.)
- Participants MUST provide their own accompanists for pieces requiring accompaniment.
- Performance from memory is recommended, but the use of a score is acceptable.
- One <u>original</u> music score or part must be provided for the judges, but you are encouraged to provide additional original scores. Photocopies are not permitted.

Participants who earn the highest ratings in either division may be asked to perform in the Young Musician's Showcase. This program gives young musicians the opportunity to participate in solo or group performances in the Ohio Theatre lobby prior to Columbus Symphony classical series concerts.
