Pursuant to the written contracts which are the subject of this litigation, any action relating to the contracts must be brought in Nassau County (see, CPLR §501). Khanna Nazarova erroneously commenced a breach of contract action in the Civil Court of the City of New York seeking damages of \$25,000.00, which sum is within the jurisdictional limitation of that court (UCCA 202). As the jurisdiction limitation of the Nassau County District Court is \$15,000.00, Khanna Nazarova could not have commenced the action in the District Court of Nassau County (UDCA 202).

The action presently pending in the Civil Court of the City of New York entitled <u>Khanna Nazarova v. Yellowbook of NY LP</u>, index number 15832 CVN 2000) is removed to the Supreme Court and venue is transferred to Nassau County (CPLR 325, 501). The movant herein is directed to serve a copy of this order upon the Clerk of the Civil Court of the City of New York forthwith. Upon receipt thereof said Clerk shall forward all papers filed under index number 15832 CVN 2000 to the Nassau County Clerk.
