



Use *LearnATest* to prepare for a variety of exams by taking practice tests and tracking your scores. The *LearnATest* database gives you free access to a variety of Licensing, Certification, Civil Service and Academic practice exams that are all based on the official tests. With a Library card and PIN, you also have access to *LearnATest* from work or home.

Getting Started

Begin at the Library's home page: www.ocls.info. Select **Virtual Library**, then choose **Online Databases**. The databases will be listed by subject. *LearnATest* may be found in the **Exams/Test Preparation** category. You may also choose **Listed by Name** from the left-hand column to see an alphabetical list of all databases.

After you have selected **LearnATest**, click on **New User** to register.
