Parent & Guest Code of Conduct

- 1. Parents & guests must promote sportsmanship & "Kids First".
- 2. Parents & guests must refrain from the use of obscene language at all MCBRB events.
- 3. Parents & guests must refrain from initiating or excessively arguing with game officials, coaches or other parents.
- 4. Parents & guests will refrain from interfering with the coaches during the games.
- 5. Parents & guests will refrain from the use of tobacco products or alcohol at all MCBRB events.
- 6. Parents & guests will follow all school and township laws, rules and policies at all MCBRB events.
- 7. With the exception of Officers of the Law, firearms will not be permitted on the premises of any Babe Ruth sponsored event regardless of the possession of a CCW permit.

Parents or spectators that do not comply with the above code will be asked to remove themselves from the MCBRB event. If the spectator does not immediately leave the premises, MCBRB reserves the right to contact the local authorities to assist in the removal of said spectator.
