Hicks, Alexander win Bruce LM Pairs

**Karl Hicks and Brian Alexander**

Longtime ACBL tournament director Karl Hicks and fellow-Canadian Brian Alexander topped the field in the three-day Bruce LM-5000 Pairs.

Hicks and Alexander had modest scores in the final round — 58% in the afternoon and 53% in the evening — but were boosted by a solid carryover from the semifinal round in which they finished seventh. They were also seventh after the qualifying round on the first day of the event.

Hicks and Alexander had a final tally of 762.32.

In second with 756.96 were Barry Purrington and Michael Cassel of Minnesota. Cassel was a defending champion in the contest. (He played with Andy Kaufman in 2006.)

Top on a board for the final day was 25.

Hicks, of Dominion NS, is a retired school principal and a 36-year veteran of the ACBL tournament directing staff. Alexander, of Fredericton NB, is a deputy minister for the province of New Brunswick. Prior to their victory, Hicks and Alexander have played together only a few times.

The contest was limited to Life Masters with fewer than 5000 masterpoints.

Martel and Zia take LM Pairs

Zia Mahmood and Chip Martel, two old friends and teammates, surged into the lead with a session to go to win the von Zedtwitz Life Master Pairs by nearly a board. Although they are rarely partners, the two often have been teammates.

The pair stood in 38th place after the first day of the three-day event. They moved up to eighth place going into yesterday's final and scored a huge 66.37% game in the afternoon, vaulting them into the lead. They had a 56.78% game in the evening session and had their win.

This was Martel's first three-day pair event victory at an NABC. "I'm frequently playing in the Grand National Teams," said Martel, "and don't get to play in this event very often."

After 11 rounds of play in the evening, Zia and Martel were in first, 54 matchpoints ahead of second place (77 was top on a board). The winners had two good last rounds.

Howard Weinstein and Renee Mancuso finished second. They had two solid games in the

final session — 58.12% in the first session and 61.44% at night — but it wasn't enough to catch Martel and Zia.

didn't stop the duo, however, from winning the six-session Young LM-1500 Pairs.

Howard lives in the Tucson AZ area but used to live in Nashville where he and Reichert, who lives here in the NABC host city, first met.

The winners were 31st after the qualifying round, but moved to second after Saturday's semifinal round. They posted a 63.89% effort in the first final session, and a 53.87% in the second final. Their six-session total was 252.17.

In second with 240.46, was the Massachusetts pair of Matthew Dyer and Doug Anderson. Top on a board for the final round was seven.

Howard is retired as the director of marketing for the Professional Golf Association. Reichert is retired from marketing with the Maytag Corporation.

The Young LM-1500 Pairs is limited to Life Masters with fewer than 1500 masterpoints.

UCLA claims Collegiate Championship

In a match that was close throughout, UCLA defeated Stanford to win the Collegiate Team Championship 112 to 91. UCLA was ahead by 10 IMPs at the half, but Stanford narrowed the score to 73 to 71 with one segment to go.

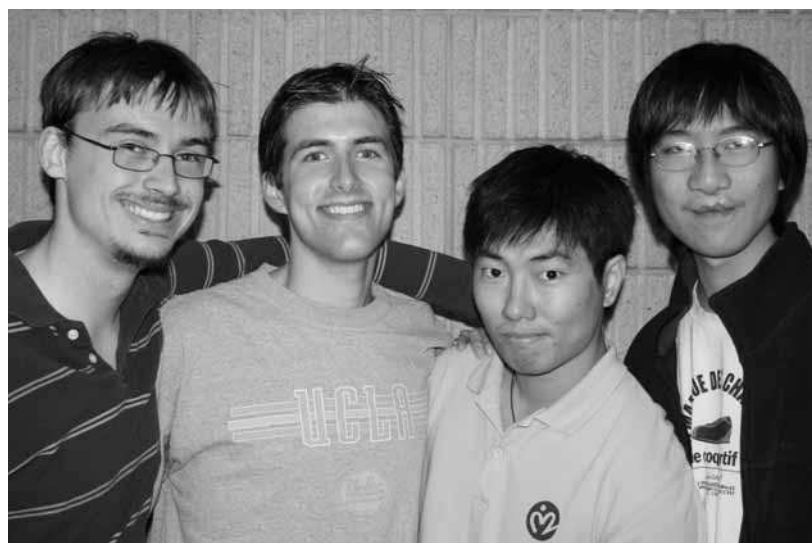
The winners are: Jeffrey Schrader, a sophomore studying mathematics; Blake Haas, a first year PhD student majoring in human genetics; Jason Chu, a first-year graduate student majoring in economics; and Barry Ko, a senior majoring in biochemistry.

The victors almost didn't make it out of the Internet qualifying where 25 teams competed. They played five-board round robin

matches and lost their first two. "Five hands is too short," said Chu. They rallied, however, and brought their "A" game to Nashville.

JUST FOR NEW PLAYERS

Responding to partner's overcall

One of the more perplexing boxes that should be filled out carefully on the convention card describes your partnership's policy for overcalls. The current overcall style is quite aggressive: Often you'll see the point range as 6 to 16 high-card points.

Remember that there are three reasons for overcalling:

1. To tell partner what to lead.
2. To interfere with the opponents' communication.

3. Because it might be your hand, even though the other side opened the bidding.

With the first two of these three reasons in mind, many players would overcall with

♠K Q J 9 2 ♥8 ♦7 5 4 3 ♣8 7 4.

It's only 6 HCP, but you surely want a spade lead, and spade overcalls use up lots of bidding room. It's this aggressive style of overcalling that has made the negative double such an important part of our bidding in the past few years. Don't forget, though, that this aggressive style is safe only at the one level. If you have to overcall at the two level, you should probably have close to an opening hand.

The third reason, with a poor suit but plenty of points, you'd also want to get into the bidding:

♠K 9 7 4 3 ♥A Q ♦K 8 6 2 ♣K 3.

This could as easily be your hand as the opponents'.

With such a wide range for overcalling, how is partner to know what to do? Here's a comfortable style for bidding when you have support for partner:

- With 6 to 9 support points and three-card support, make a single raise.

• With four-card support and 6-8 support points, make a double raise (no Alert necessary in this competitive auction). Jumps to the three and to the four level are weak and preemptive.

• With 10 or more support points (HCP plus distributional values), cuebid the opponent's suit. This should get partner's attention! You either have support or you know where you're going without support.

But what should you do when you don't have support for partner? Look at the lower part of the Overcall box on the convention card. You'll see that a new suit can be forcing, not forcing but constructive or not forcing. Which should you use?

Let's deal with forcing first. You have the cuebid available to tell partner you have a big hand, so you don't need to make a change of suit forcing.

On the other hand, making a non-forcing bid on a very weak hand is really dangerous. Let's say partner overcalls a 1♣ opener with 1♠, and you have a very bad hand:

♠6 ♥Q 10 9 7 6 4 ♦8 5 3 ♣Q 6 2.

You certainly don't like spades, but anything you do might just make matters worse. After all, partner didn't invite you to the party.

Most of the time, honor partner's wishes about overcalls. When you do decide to offer an alternative, the non-forcing but constructive approach would mean, for instance, that when partner overcalls 1♠, you would bid 2♥ with a hand such as

♠9 2 ♥K Q 10 8 4 3 ♣A 6 3 ♣K 8.

You have a doubleton spade, what is called "tolerance" for partner's suit. And you have a suit you like and a reasonable HCP strength. If partner can't tolerate hearts and has to bid 2♠, you won't be squirming and wishing you'd never



spoken.

What if you have a decent hand but no tolerance for partner's suit? You have several choices. One is to pass. If you have a misfit, perhaps it's better to stay low. And there are those who say that if there is a misfit, let partner play it. Another choice is to cuebid to see if partner has anything else to tell you. Then when you bid your own suit, you show a very good hand but no support for partner, a hand such as:

♠6 ♥K Q J 9 2 ♦A K 8 ♣Q 9 3.

A third choice is to bid your suit with a jump. This is not forcing — only a cuebid is forcing — and it promises a good, long suit while denying tolerance for partner's suit. You might have

♠6 ♥K Q J 9 7 4 2 ♦A 8 3 ♣6 2

for such a jump. Note that you have a decent hand, just no tolerance for spades.

Opening lead: ♣A.

Bidding commentary: North bids 3♠, hoping South can bid 3NT. South is allowed to raise a second suit with only three cards because South has previously denied four spades with the 3♦ rebid. The raise to 4♠ shows three strong spades. North's spades are relatively weak, so North decides to play in a contract with nine trumps as opposed to seven.

Lead commentary: Eskimos in Alaska know

that neither North nor South has a club stopper. If North had one, he would have bid 3NT over 3♦. If South had one, he would have bid 3NT over 3♠. It doesn't matter what West has in clubs, a club lead is automatic given this revealing sequence.

Defensive commentary: If West wins the second club, he should exit passively with a diamond or a heart. If East wins the second club, the only safe exit is a diamond. Sometimes you have to sit back and wait for the setting trick and not break a suit (spades) that could cost a trick.

Play commentary: Declarer needs to take the

rest of the tricks and has a choice of several finesses. There is the heart finesse or the spade finesse in either direction. To maximize chances, declarer draws trumps and plays the ♥A and ♥K, then ruffs a heart. If the queen falls (it does), South's spade problems are over. A spade can be discarded on the ♥J. If the ♥Q doesn't drop, South has to guess spades. A good ploy is to lead the ♠J. If West covers, South's problems are over. If West ducks smoothly, South might decide to rise with the ♠K and play East for the ♠Q.

No phones

Cell phones, audible pagers or any similar communication equipment may not be operated or operable in the playing area during a session of play at NABCs except for health-related equipment or by permission of the director-in-charge of the tournament or event.

Pre-Alert/ Disclosure forms

If your partnership plays special overcalls, you must fill out a pre-Alert/Disclosure form and make it available to your opponents when you play in events that allow Mid-Chart and Super-Chart conventions.

This applies to NABC+, regional or higher knockout and Flight A Swiss games. Look for the light blue forms on the table where convention cards are available.

Bid Box Alerts and Announcements

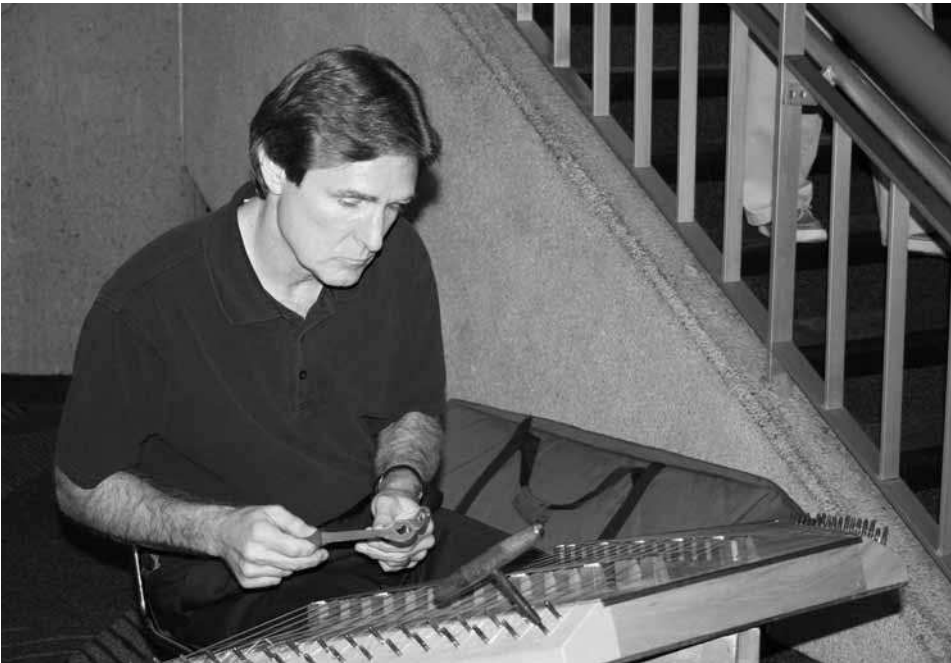
When using bid boxes, ACBL suggests that players tap the Alert strip and say “Alert” at the same time.

When making an announcement, use the announcement word — such as “transfer” — and tap the Alert strip at the same time.

A player who Alerts or announces a bid should make sure his opponents are aware that an Alert or announcement has been made.

Notice to players

Each player must have an ACBL convention card filled out and on the table. Please note that other types of convention cards, such as the WBF convention card or homemade cards that do not sufficiently resemble the ACBL convention card, are not acceptable substitutes.

Mr. Smith misses Nashville

The semifinal of the top bracket of the Music City KO saw Rose Meltzer’s Polish/Norwegian/USA alliance take on the Rabbi Leonard Helman’s squad. In an amusing twist the first half saw the Rabbi – a reigning Polish KO team champion – face Poland’s number one pair.

After 11 boards Meltzer led 17-9. The Rabbi faced a defensive problem on the final deal of the first half:

South led the ♣6 and declarer put up dummy’s king and played a diamond to the 9 and 2. The ♦J put the Rabbi on lead for the one and only time.

His decision to play a club did not turn out well, as declarer could win and knock out the ♦A to record plus 400 and earn the only double-digit swing of the entire match – more than enough to ensure victory.

South had resisted the temptation to rebid 1NT – as it happens it would have worked well, as North would have bid 2♥ – a comfortable spot for North-South.

If North-South had been using it, the Smith Echo carding convention would have saved the day.

It’s a simple principle: assuming there are no overriding issues within a suit, an echo by either player in the suit declarer leads at trick two shows enthusiasm for the suit originally led, whereas a failure to echo shows a lack of interest in the suit. Here South’s ♦2 would have said “I don’t like clubs,” and North would surely have switched to a heart, giving the defense six tricks.

The late Rixi Markus maintained that there was almost always a way of putting a contract under pressure, and Karen McCallum found a way to do just that on a deal from the Life Master Pairs.

It seemed pretty clear from the auction that the only key card that would be missing was the ♣A and in light of the opening bid, it hardly figured to be well placed. So, in an attempt to confuse declarer Karen led the ♠2!

The sight of dummy was hardly inspiring, but declarer gave the matter some thought and eventually played the ♣10. That looked promising, but now it was South’s turn to think. It was disappointing, but hardly surprising when she played low and all hope of defeating the contract had vanished.

Of course, as the cards lie the contract should not fail, but had South put up the ♣J there is always the chance that declarer might have tried a ruffing finesse in clubs at some point.

I guess you could say that the operation was a success, but the patient died.

Why draw trumps?

When you have a nine-card trump fit missing the queen, guessing whether to finesse or play for the drop is often a problem. It’s especially a problem when you are playing in a slam and missing a side ace!

In Sunday’s Strati-Flighted A/X Swiss Teams, there was no bidding by East-West at one table. The ♠4 was led. With nothing to go on, declarer won and played the ♥A and another heart. Now East had a sure trump trick and the ♦A was the setting trick.

Jan Assini didn’t try to guess trumps when she also declared 6♥ — she had a better plan. The ♠4 was led and Assini, playing with Frank Aquila of Fairlawn OH, won with the ♠A, discarding a diamond from dummy. She played a club to the ♣A, and ruffed a club. She then led the ♦4 to dummy’s king, losing to the ace. When West exited with a diamond, declarer won the ♦Q and continued with the ♠K discarding the remaining diamond from dummy.

Assini now led the ♠5 and ruffed with dummy’s ♥2. She led another club from dummy and ruffed with her ♥7 as East discarded a spade (and not a diamond!). She advanced the (now good) ♠10 and West ruffed with his ♥8, overruffed by dummy’s ♥J. At trick 10, she led a club from dummy and ruffed with her ♥9.

Assini now led the ♦7. Because she had played the way she did, she had a pretty good idea of how the opponents’ cards were divided. Assini reasoned that if East had a third diamond, he would have discarded that instead of a spade when she led the third round of clubs. Assini ruffed the diamond with dummy’s ♥K, therefore, as East underruffed. The ♥A 10 took the last two tricks.

On this deal (rotated) from the final of the Grand National Team Championship Flight, the defense was presented with a challenge in how to discourage partner from continuing a suit in which the signaler has a very strong holding. How do you get partner to turn directions?

At one table, Robert Levin and Glenn Milgrim (District 24) arrived in 3NT by South, which was defeated two tricks when the defenders, Jeff Meckstroth and Eric Rodwell (District 9) took the first five diamond tricks and a slow spade trick.

At the other table, David Berkowitz and Larry Cohen (District 9), arrived in 4♠ with the North-South cards on this auction against Chris Willenken and Roy Welland:

(1) Precision. How should defense take its four tricks: two diamonds, a club and a spade?

Cohen writes: *A club lead would beat 4 ♠ easily. West, however, reasonably led the ♦A. How should East signal? He is desperate for a club switch. He discouraged in diamonds with the hope that partner would read this as requiring the “obvious” shift, probably to clubs. West did switch, but to hearts. This could have been right if declarer held K-x in clubs and x-x in hearts, but I think the actual layout in which South holds the ♥A was more likely in view of the strong 1 ♣ opening.*

East-West were playing upside-down carding, so the “discouraging” signal was the ♦9. Maybe West would read that as suit preference for hearts? How should East get a club switch? The ♦J? If West played another diamond (other than the 10 to hold the lead), East would win and be endplayed.

Anyway, after the heart shift, I had 10 easy tricks. (I was a bit surprised by the 5-0 break, but I had the extra trick to throw a loser).

This result gave our team 11 IMPs, and pushed our lead to more than 40 with only five deals to go.

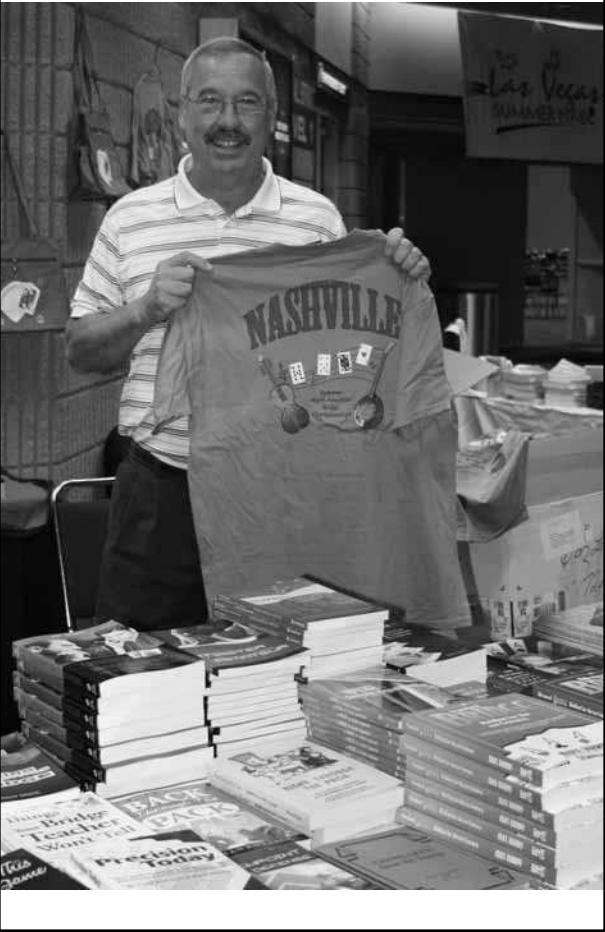

Wagar KO starts today

The Wagar Women’s Knockout Teams gets underway today, and at stake is the Wagar Trophy, which honors one of the all-time great players.

Margaret Wagar (1902-1990), inducted into the ACBL Bridge Hall of Fame in 1999, became Life Master #37 in 1943, the fifth woman to earn the rank. She and Kay Rhodes share one of the most remarkable achievements in ACBL history — they won the Women’s Pairs four consecutive years: 1955, 1956, 1957 and 1958.



Wagar and Rhodes share another record — one of frustration. They were second in the Women’s Teams for seven consecutive years, 1952-1958.

Wagar’s impressive record spans three decades and includes wins in women’s and open competition. Her open wins include the Reisinger in 1941, the Open Pairs (the forerunner of the Blue Ribbon Pairs) in 1947 and 1948 and the Spingold in 1946 and 1948.

Wagar served on the ACBL Board of Directors from 1960 to 1972 and was named *ACBL Honorary Member* in 1979. She was non-playing captain of the U.S. World Women’s Teams in 1968 and 1972.

Winners and runners-up

Until 1976 the Women’s Teams was a four-session event scored by Board-a-Match. It was contested as a three-session championship until 1972 and again in 1975.

The Women’s Teams was held at the Fall NABC until 1963. In 1976 the event became a Women’s KO with Swiss qualifying.

History of the Spingold

The Spingold Master Knockout Teams, first known as the Challenge Knockout Teams, was contested for the Asbury Park Trophy in the early days.

The runner-up team in the regularly-scheduled portion of the event had the right to challenge the winners to a playoff. This right was never utilized.

In 1934, 1936 and 1937, the Masters Teams-of-Four and the Asbury Park Trophy were separate events, providing two sets of winners.

In 1938 the event became the Spingold Master Knockout Teams and a part of the Summer NABC.

At one time, the Spingold was a double elimination event, usually lasting nine or 10 sessions. It was scored by International Match Points and was restricted to players with 100 or more masterpoints.

In 1965, the double elimination method was replaced by three qualifying sessions (subsequently reduced to two), followed by single elimination knockout matches. The preliminary qualifying session were dropped in 1970.

The Spingold Trophy, donated by Nathan B. Spingold in 1934; the Vanderbilt Trophy, awarded to the winners of the Vanderbilt Knockout Teams at the Spring NABC, and the Reisinger Memorial Trophy, donated by the Greater New York Bridge Association in memory of Curt H. Reisinger and awarded to the winners of the Reisinger Board-a-Match Teams, are ACBL's most highly prized team trophies.

Spingold (1886-1958), a New York publicist, motion picture executive and patron of the arts, was one of the most influential men in bridge administration from 1937 to 1943.

Born in Chicago, he became a reporter on The Chicago Examiner, The Chicago Record Herald and The Chicago Tribune. Spingold's interest in show business brought him to New York City in the Thirties.

In 1932 he joined Columbia Pictures in a public relations capacity. He was named to the board of directors in 1940 and three years later was appointed vice president in charge of advertising, publicity and development. He became a vice president of the company in 1954.

Active in bridge from its earliest days, Spingold was named ABL Honorary Member in 1936. He was instrumental in effecting a peaceful merger between the American Bridge League and the United States Bridge Association in 1937 and became president of the newly formed American Contract Bridge League the following year.

He served for many years on the League's Board of Governors and Board of Directors. Spingold was also president of the Cavendish Club in New York.

(opposite the driver). Each has a “Bridge Buggy” sign as well as another sign to identify the mission (route) it is currently on.

Hotel Service

Service begins at 8 each morning, and it will run continuously through most of the day. There will be planned breaks in service for an hour at 10 a.m. and for a half hour at 1 p.m. Service will be more frequent before and after the bridge events.

Hotels served include the Sheraton, Best Western, Holiday Inn Express, Hampton Inn (4th and Korean War Veterans), Courtyard Inn (4th and Church) and Doubletree. Guests at the Wyndham should walk to the Holiday Inn.

Dinnertime Shuttle Changes

There is no longer a West End Dinner route. The Downtown Dinner and Hotel shuttle loops have been combined between the hours of 4 and 8 p.m. This concentrates more resources to moving everyone from the Convention Center to their hotels and /or the many downtown area eating establishments.

In addition, the black van will transport you to either Nashville’s famous Swett’s for great soul food or to Germantown for Monell’s, Mad Platter or Germantown Cafe. Request these locations to the van driver and he will arrange a time to retrieve you.

Convention Center is the Hub

Important: The Convention Center loading and

unloading point is the Commerce Street entrance. This also applies to tours or any other special transportation.

LP Field Parking

If not staying downtown, you can park in Lot A / B at the Titans stadium lot at LP Field. This is an existing service for people who work downtown, and is available for us during the tournament.

Just check in with the security guard. Cost is generally free, but if the lot fills, the overflow lot is \$1. They have an existing shuttle service that costs \$1 each way. Look for the bright yellow Park It bus.

There is a change, however, from previous information published (web site, etc.). They will not be altering their route during the tournament. The nearest stops to the convention center are 4th & Church (Courtyard by Marriott) where you can transfer to our hotel shuttle service. Or, you can exit at the next stop, 3rd and Commerce. Both stops are about two blocks away, but 3rd and Commerce is generally uphill.

The yellow shuttle service runs from 7 a.m. to 6:30 p.m. Return service is from either of the aforementioned stops. The frequency is normally every 20 minutes, but every 10 minutes at peak, from 7 a.m. to 9 a.m. and from 4 p.m. to 6 p.m.

After 6:30 p.m. use the Downtown Dinner route, and ask the driver to drop you off at LP Field. After 10 p.m., request service from either the driver of either the Minibus or the Passenger Van as they stand or stop at the Convention Center.

Important – this parking option is not available on the last Saturday or Sunday of the tournament.

Vanderbilt Bridge Club

You can park and ride from the Vanderbilt Bridge Club.

Departure times: 8 a.m. & 11 a.m.

Return service:

- 1. Black van at dinner break
- 2. Midnight from the Convention Center.

Look for the Bus!

Generally, the services are to be provided in a continuous loop, and there will not be scheduled arrival or departure times. No announcement will be made in the hotels. Please: it is important that you actively look for the bus so that you make the connection! The bus will wait only a couple of minutes at each “stop,” and if no patrons are seen, the driver will move on to the next location. Especially on the dinner routes. Be prepared to get the driver’s attention. Many of these streets are very busy or narrow, and they are not conducive to any type of long-term stop or blockage of other traffic.

Hotel Service Frequency (note – these are estimates)

Sheraton: 8 a.m. to 10 a.m., 11 a.m. to 1 p.m., 10 minutes; all other service periods – 20 to 30 minutes. All other hotels, 20 to 30 minutes during service periods.
