




long /a/ words

- The long *a* sound can be spelled by using the letters a__e or ai
- Examples: state, pain, make, paint

-long /e/ words

- The long *e* sound can be spelled by using the letters e__e, ee, or ea
- Examples: theme, street, weep, leaf
