Syracuse Obedience Training Club (SOTC) is a fully matted, air conditioned, indoor facility in one large room. Crating and grooming space is available near the conformation ring. NO CHALKING is permitted inside of the building. Crates must be able to be stacked if necessary, and no exercise pens will be permitted indoors. There is ample parking space provided, but limited grassy area. All exhibitors are required to clean up behind their dogs. Absolutely no dogs may be left in the building overnight. There will be a food vendor on site. Located near Carrier Circle, there is easy access to Syracuse Hancock International Airport.

Conformation Information, Altered and Intact

Conformation will be held indoors on matting. There will be nearby set-up areas for grooming and crating (stackable crates, no ex-pens). Dog and Bitch schedules will be sent with confirmation of entry. Class schedule is subject to change. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents are responsible for having their dog at the ring when their class is called to be judged. Neither the Host Club nor its Show Committee is responsible or obligated to furnish any service of notifying exhibitors of their class judging. Dogs will enter the ring in catalog order unless otherwise posted. *Awards* include BOB, BOS, BOW, WD, WB, Reserve WD, Reserve WB, and Premier Dogs and Premier Bitches.

Junior Handling Information

Ownership rules must be followed to earn points. Please refer to the ASCA Rules and Regulations for Junior Handling and Junior Finals at www.asca.org. A change of dogs must be made at least one hour prior to the judging of the class and be approved by the Junior Chairperson.

Do I have to have a tracking number to compete?

No, you do not need a tracking number in order to compete in Agility or Stock.

You will need a tracking number to enter an Obedience trial or Tracking Test.

Your dog does not have to be a purebred to receive a tracking number from ASCA®.

Why would I need or want a tracking number for my dog?

If you would like to have your dog's points and titles recorded by ASCA®, and if you'd like to receive title certificates in the mail for your accomplishments, you might want to obtain a tracking number.

How much is the total cost for a tracking number?

In order to obtain a tracking number for your dog, you must be at least a "Service" member. The cost for Service Membership is **\$10**.

- Your membership is good for one year; however, it does not need to be maintained in subsequent years, unless you want to obtain another tracking number for another dog after your membership has expired.

This membership fee is **in addition** to the tracking fee of **\$10** per dog. A tracking number is good for the lifetime of the dog. If you only have one dog, the total cost would be **\$20**. For two dogs, the cost would be **\$30**, etc.
