New Volunteer Opportunity Descriptions

Pizza Supply Coordinator (Weekly)

Students have the option of having a pizza lunch each Wednesday. Those who sign up for weekly pizza also receive a healthy side dish to go with their lunch. In addition, napkins and plates are provided to the classroom for pizza. The MPA purchases the side, napkins, and plates weekly. The Pizza Supply Coordinator would be in charge of purchasing the nutritional side, plates, and napkins. The volunteer would also need to divide the supplies into classrooms and deliver the supply bags to the office every Tuesday. The MPA will reimburse for purchases made weekly.

Sidewalk Botanist

The MPA keeps the campus colorful and seasonal with potted plants outside of the classroom doors (12 pots). The Sidewalk Botanist would pick out the flowers for their chosen season, plant them in the pots, and water the Children's House planters once a week. The other planters will be maintained by the students. The MPA will reimburse for purchases of flowers.

Garden Party

The Garden Party group will meet once a month to tidy up the campus grounds. No specific time commitment is needed. Volunteers are welcome to pull weeds and chat for as long or as little time as they have. Others are welcome to stay longer for larger projects.

Prep Week for Gingerbread Week

The week in December prior to "Gingerbread Week" is when the real magic happens. The MPA sponsors Gingerbread Week yearly by purchasing cookies, houses, candy, and icing that brings the fun to the classrooms. The MPA is in need of the following volunteers:

<u>Candy Coordinator</u>: This volunteer would take a trip to BJ's to load his/her cart full of all the supplies the children will need. The MPA will provide you with the teacher-approved list. The MPA will reimburse for all purchases made.

<u>Candy Sorters</u>: Join a few other volunteers to sit and sort candy into individual bags for the children to use to decorate their gingerbread cookies.

Gingerbread Pick-Up Help: Julie Hawkins in Art Land orders gingerbread cookies for every child in Toddler House and Children's House as well as a gingerbread house for each child in Elementary and Middle School. It is quite a feat to get these from the bakery in Marshfield! We need a few drivers to caravan over to the bakery with Julie. This is usually done in the morning on the Thursday or Friday prior to Gingerbread Week in December.

Great Room Family Movie Night!

In April, the MPA will host three family movie nights for the children at Bay Farm. A volunteer is needed for each movie night. Responsibilities include selecting and acquiring an age-appropriate movie and soliciting volunteers to bring refreshments. The office will help communicate the event to families.

The last day of school is field day. The MPA is in need of field day captains to coordinate activities for their specific groups (i.e. Children's House, Elementary, etc.).
