Annual Meeting Highlights

The Western North Carolina Via de Cristo Annual Meeting was held on August 19th at Bethany Lutheran in Hickory. Pastor Greg Williams led the Worship Service. Larry Witham led the Business meeting and gave a brief report of the past year. Various committee chairpersons gave reports. One item mentioned at the meeting was the expenses of weekends and the need for team members to ensure that they promptly pay their weekend fees, and that sponsors should ensure that their pilgrims' fees are paid if a scholarship has not been requested. Elections were held to fill three secretariat positions whose terms will expire this year. The election results are:

What is this thing called the Secretariat?

Now you may be wondering, just what does the Secretariat do? The Secretariat functions much like your church council, but in addition to the officers such as director, secretary and treasurer, the Secretariat is comprised of the following committee chairs:

- Lay Director –presides at all meetings of the Movement and the Secretariat and acts as official spokesperson for the Movement, as well as other duties.
- **Secretary** records the minutes of all meetings and maintains custody of all recorded material of the organization
- **Treasurer** has custody of and keeps records of all financial resources of the Movement and expends monies authorized by the Secretariat
- **Spiritual Directors** provides spiritual guidance, and safeguards the Gospel and the theological integrity of the Movement
- Pre Via de Cristo processes applications for weekends to ensure compliance
 with the guidelines established by the Secretariat, and presides at send-offs at the
 start of each weekend
- Via de Cristo responsible for the selection and procurement of facilities, property and materials for the weekends. The team assists in the setup and clean up of the weekend.
- Post Via de Cristo responsible for the continued contact of the Cursillistas with one another after the weekend. The committee coordinates and assists with Group Reunion and Ultreya activities (See "Secretariat", Page 4)

Directions for Camp Loy White - See page 3 for Trinity Lutheran Church Directions

Beginning at the I-40/321/127 interchange in Hickory, take exit 42 off of Hwy.321 and travel south on Hwy.127 for 5.7 miles to Hwy 10. At Hwy 10 go west (right) toward Shelby for 9.5 miles. At the intersection of Hwy. 10 & 18 go south (left) on Hwy 18 toward Shelby for 11.1 miles. You are now in the Belwood community. Look for Belwood and a small Loy White sign on the right. Turn right on to Carpenter's Grove Church Road and travel 2.4 miles to St. Paul's Church Road (small Loy White sign on the right). Turn left and travel 2 miles to Hull road. Only ½ a mile to go (BIG Loy White sign on the right). Turn left onto gravel road into campground. **NOTE:** When leaving the camp take only right turns until you reach Hwy.18.

- Leaders responsible for maintaining a file of human resources to assist in the selection of Rectors and other team members. This committee shall maintain and make available educational materials for team meetings and VdC weekends
- Sponsorship/Leadership Training responsible for providing training for potential sponsors
- Music responsible for the coordination of music including maintaining songbooks, providing guidance to Rectors, Music Chas and serenade leaders and ensuring copyright compliance
- Communications responsible for the communication of general information to the members of the Movement. This committee will also communicate with other Via de Cristo movements to solicit palanca from and provide to those movements.
- National Delegate representative to the National Lutheran Secretariat; attends the annual meeting of the NLS and reports back to the Movement.
- Outreach responsible for all activities related to working with other Cursillo-based movements and in reaching out to clergy and laypersons about Via de Cristo
