Tapit broke his own progeny earnings record in 2015

2015 LEADING SIRE: TAPIT

The 2015 race for leading general sire was over before it began as Gainesway's Tapit jumped off to an early lead that he never relinquished en route to record progeny earnings of more than \$18.25 million, through Dec. 29, exceeding his own previous single-season record of \$16.8 million established in 2014.

Tapit's leading earner among his 23 stakes winners in 2015 was Frosted—Wood Memorial (gr. I) winner and runner-up in the Belmont Stakes (gr. I)—who bankrolled \$1.9 million.

The unchallenged leading North American sire, Tapit will stand for a 2016 fee of \$300,000, unchanged from 2015.

While Tapit was the leader by progeny earnings and winners (with 174), deceased Ashford stallion Scat Daddy led in other key categories. The ninth-leading sire by earnings, Scat Daddy was represented by 30 stakes winners that won 47 stakes, including 17 graded stakes winners and six grade I winners.

Following Tapit on the general sire list was Darley's Medaglia d'Oro, with \$13.19 million. **BH**

LEADING TURF SIRE: KITTEN'S JOY

For the third successive year, Ramsey Farm's prepotent Kitten's Joy is North America's leading turf sire by progeny earnings, winners, and black-type winners.

Candidate for championship female turf honors, Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Turf (gr. IT) winner Stephanie's Kitten is his chief earner, bankrolling \$1,658,800 of his unassailable \$9,243,309 turf earnings for 2015, more than double his nearest competitor, Medaglia d'Oro, with \$4,580,607. Kitten's Joy's also ranks fourth on the general sire list with \$11,494,520.

Kitten's Joy, 2004's champion turf male, has 80 turf winners this year—20 more than Giant's Causeway—and 11 black-type winners, including two-time grade I winner Big Blue Kitten, who is a candidate for championship honors as leading turf male.

Other top progeny include Chiropractor, his sire's third grade I winner this year, as well as Charming Kitten, who became his eighth graded winner this year in the Dec. 26 W. L. McKnight Stakes (gr. IIIT) at Gulfstream Park.

A 14-year-old son of El Prado, Kitten's Joy will stand in 2016 for \$100,000, unchanged from last year. **BH**

RIVALRY MOVES TO AUCTION RING

The torrid racetrack rivalry between Pierro and All Too Hard is set to reignite in the auction ring when the 2016 Gold Coast Magic Millions yearling sale gets underway Jan. 6.

The best son of champion racehorse and sire Lonhro, Pierro was an unbeaten champion 2-year-old who closed his career at 3 with the impressive record of 11 wins—five at the group I level—from 14 starts.

All Too Hard, a half brother to undefeated superstar Black Caviar, was a promising 2-year-old who advanced sharply at 3 to challenge Pierro—whom he defeated in the Caulfield Guineas (Aus-I)—and kept improving as the season progressed to retire with seven wins, including four group I stakes, from 12 starts.

Both retired to stud in 2013, Pierro to Coolmore (Aus\$77,000 fee) and All Too Hard (Aus\$66,000) to

Vinery. They covered many of the country's best mares, and how their progeny will be received at Magic Millions is a hot topic. **BH**

SPECTACULAR BID'S SOPHOMORE SEASON OPENER

No sooner does Baby New Year toddle through the 2016 door, than the trails to the classics open,

and several are scheduled on this weekend's racing cards. At Gulfstream Park, the six-furlong Hutcheson Stakes (gr. III) takes front and center.

In 1979 Spectacular Bid was the first Hutcheson winner to add the Kentucky Derby (gr. I). On Feb. 7, Hawksworth Farm's steel gray son of Bold Bidder, carrying a five-race win streak from his championship juvenile season, opened his 3-year-old campaign in the seven-furlong Hutcheson's 26th running. His sophomore journey began with a 3 3/4-length trouncing of three rivals.

Four more Derby preps and four more wins followed, and he remained undefeated through the Derby and the Preakness Stakes (gr. I).

An errant safety pin derailed the Triple Crown train and a 12-race win streak, but he added champion 3-year-old male honors at year's end.

An incredible competitor, Spectacular Bid went undefeated at 4 in nine races—including a walkover in the Woodward Stakes (gr. I). He was named Horse of the Year and champion older horse. **BH**

FLEXIBILITY LIMBERS UP IN JEROME

Flexibility is a proven colt in graded stakes around two turns at Aqueduct Racetrack and rates the nod over a field of eight other freshly turned 3-year-olds in the Jan. 2 Jerome Stakes (gr. III) at the Big A. The \$200,000 feature will be run at one mile and 70 yards on the inner dirt course.

New York-bred Flexibility broke his maiden against state-bred company at first asking, then finished second in the Nashua and Remsen (both gr. II) stakes, each time falling just short of Mohaymen. He will take some beating here.

Donegal Moon has already been two turns four times and possesses the speed to be dangerous. He faded after setting the pace in the Remsen. Bird of Trey has dominated Pennsylvania-breds but needs to prove himself in open company and around two turns. Vorticity won the Marylander Stakes at Laurel Park last out and will also be forwardly placed. King Kranz, although still a maiden after five starts, was second in the Futurity Stakes (gr. II) at Belmont Park. **BH**

JACKS OR BETTER HAS PAIR AT GULFSTREAM

Two colts by Florida stallion Awesome of Course—both owned and bred by Jacks or Better Farm—should grab plenty of attention when they compete in a couple of early-season 3-year-olds stakes at Gulfstream Park Jan 2.

Awesome Banner, out of the Zamindar mare Miranda Stands, last raced at Gulfstream June 5 but left an impression. He demolished a maiden special weight field by almost 10 lengths in track-record time for 4 1/2 furlongs.

Trainer Stanley Gold called the jump up to the Hutcheson Stakes (gr. III) "Plan B," because ideally Awesome Banner would have raced in an entry-level allowance race before the six-furlong stakes.

In the one-turn mile Mucho Macho Man Stakes, the more experienced Fellowship, winner of the lucrative 1 1/16-mile Florida Sire In Reality Stakes division, will make his eighth start for Jacks or Better and Gold. Out of the Demidoff mare Go Girlfriend Go, Fellowship has more than held his own in open company.

"I'm not sure how much potential he has," Gold said of Fellowship. **BH**

IT'S ALL ABOUT THE RACEHORSE

When the Thoroughbred Aftercare Alliance was officially launched in February 2012, it had only two key goals—but that doesn't mean they were easily attainable.

In the 10 years prior, much had been accomplished in aftercare by organizations around the country with a heart for ensuring retired Thoroughbreds were cared for, given homes and, ideally, retrained for other disciplines. There was, however, no umbrella organization to perform two important functions—accreditation and fundraising—on a national level.

The TAA in four years has become more than just another horse racing alphabet soup organization, perhaps because it's about the horse and nothing else. But the endeavor costs money, and accrediting aftercare facilities is much different than accrediting racetracks under the NTRA Safety and Integrity Alliance.

In 2013 the TAA awarded about \$1 million in grants to 23 accredited aftercare organizations; the following year the amount more than doubled to \$2.4 million, while 2015 grants totaled \$2.48 million for 56 accredited organizations.

The numbers can be deceptive. TAA operations consultant Stacie Clark Rogers noted that some of the organizations have multiple facilities around the United States, so the total is closer to 180. To apply for accreditation, a facility needs to have only five Thoroughbreds, have been in business three years, and be a 501(c)3 charity.

Clark Rogers said that in 2015, TAA-accredited organizations were responsible for roughly 5,000 Thoroughbreds tracked under accreditation protocol. An inventory system, she said, is being developed as part of The Jockey Club horse farm management system.

Facility inspections involve more than assessing the health of horses. Accreditation

requires examining finances, herd size, staffing, and adoption policies. Facility managers are required to submit reports every six months.

"Early on in the process the board realized it was important not to just raise money but to find the best organizations to raise the money for," Clark Rogers said. "There needed to be a system of accreditation. Developing it took quite a while. An accredited facility has to be one people are comfortable investing their money into. It has to have a business plan behind it."

It appears to be working. TAA organizers said facilities look at accreditation as a badge of honor. Danielle Nichter, TAA marketing and communications coordinator, noted that some individuals who previously owned retired racehorses follow their progress through the organization.

The laundry list of organizations and individuals that contribute to the TAA is an indication that awareness has grown. But there is more to do in terms of the funding mechanism, according to Ashton Moynihan, TAA funding projects coordinator.

"There is a hands-on, grassroots effort to explain what we do and how we're different," she said. **BH**
