The Girl Scouts of Kentuckiana is an American Red Cross (ARC) licensed training provider. You will receive a discounted combo price of \$35 when you take both CPR (ARC) and First Aid (ARC) through our training calendar. The costs listed below are the cost for the GSK sponsored ARC courses. Fees may vary by provider.

Who can attend Adult Education courses?

Adult education courses are open to all registered adults. Ambassador Girl Scouts are also welcome to attend appropriate courses.

I'm a new volunteer. What courses do I need to take?

There are recommended and required courses for new volunteers (see below list). Required courses in **bold**.

- · GS101
- · Shield the Vulnerable
- Pathway Orientation
- First Aid/CPR (see course description)
- · Grade Level Courses
- Camp In A and B

How do I register for a course?

Visit the Girl Scouts of Kentuckiana Volunteer Training and Events calendar at www.gskentuckiana.org for online registration, or use the registration form located in the back of this guide. Advance registration is required for all courses.

How much does it cost to take a course?

Most courses are provided without charge as a service of the council. When a fee is charged, it will be listed on the course description, and is due at the time of registration.

Is financial assistance available?

Financial assistance is available for adult education courses. The application is available online at www.gskentuckiana.org. Search for Financial Assistance Application under Resources. Submit this form to your local Program and Learning Center when registering for a course.

Will my course registration be confirmed?

Yes. Course registration confirmations are emailed.

What should I bring to class?

Always bring note-taking materials and your adult education training card. Some courses require additional materials; please check the course description and registration confirmation for details. Please do not bring children to workshops unless childcare is specially noted. This is for your child's safety and the consideration of those in attendance.

How do I cancel my course registration?

Please call Kasey Bryant, Training and Toop Support Specialist at least 10 business days prior to the training to cancel your registration for a full refund. If an emergency situation arises, and you need to cancel your registration, please notify Kasey as soon as possible. Refunds are available for cancellations due to medical reasons, personal injury, or death in the family when notified at least 24 hours before the training.

Will I be notified if my course is cancelled or full?

Yes, if the minimum number of participants is not met, the course may be cancelled. If the course is full, cancelled, or changed in any way, you will be notified by phone or email.

Important Information - FAQs

I cancelled my registration. Can I get a refund?

Fees for council-cancelled courses are refundable or transferable within the same year. Fees for courses which are held, but which you do not attend, are forfeited. We will not guarantee a refund for cancellations on trainings less than 10 business days out, unless the cancellation is due to medical reasons, personal injury, or death in the family.

Does GSK keep track of training records?

Yes, your training records are recorded at the GSK Council office. It is recommended that you also keep track of the courses you have taken on the Record of Adult Education wallet card.

Are training patches available?

Yes, train car patches are available for most adult education courses. These patches (\$1.25) may be purchased when you register online or through your local Girl Scout Shop.

I don't see the training I need. How do I schedule training?

Training for groups is available upon request. Please contact your local Training and Troop Support (pg 16) for more information.
