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Welcome to World's Greatest Bible Puzzles, Volume 11—Word Games!

If you like Bible word games, you'll love this book. Here are 120 puzzles to expand your Bible knowledge and test your puzzle solving skills. With each puzzle based on the King James Version of the Bible, you're in for hours of fun!

World's Greatest Bible Puzzles, Volume 11—Word Games contains several types of puzzles, including

Acrostics: Read the definition in the left-hand column and write the word it describes in the right-hand column. Then place the decoded letters from the right-hand column in the puzzle form following to spell out the Bible verse indicated.

Anagrams: Rearrange the letters of the nonsensical words and phrases given to create another word or phrase from the Bible.

Bible Quotation Puzzles: Place the letters in each column into the preceding puzzle grid to form words. The letters may or may not fit into the grid in the same order in which they're given; black spaces indicate the ends of words. When a letter has been used, cross it off and do not use it again. When the grid has been properly filled in, you'll be able to read a Bible verse by scanning the lines of the grid from left to right.

Bible Sudoku: Each 9 x 9 grid includes "givens," as with traditional Sudoku puzzles. In this case, the givens are nine unique letters—which will spell out a biblical word or phrase. The nine-letter word or phrase is determined from the scripture printed below the puzzle. Solving the puzzle involves placing the nine letters in each row, column, and 3 x 3 minigrid (the white and shaded areas) so that no letter is duplicated in a row, column, or minigrid. Use your skills of deduction!

CryptoScriptures: Each of the CryptoScriptures is a Bible verse in substitution code. For example, the word JEHOVAH might become MPXSTQV if M is substituted for J, P for E, X for H, etc. One way to break the code is to look for repeated letters: E, T, A, O, N, R, and I are the most often used. A single letter is usually A or I. OF, IT, and IS are common two-letter words. Try THE or AND for a three-letter group. The code is different for each CryptoScripture.

Drop Two Puzzles: Remove two letters from each seven-letter word in the left-hand column to create a new five-letter word (you may need to rearrange the remaining letters). Put the two dropped letters into the spaces to the right of the blanks. Then use these letters to spell out a phrase or sentence from the Bible.

Scrambled Circles: Unscramble the letters from the list provided, placing the corrected words in the numbered blanks. Then use the circled letters to answer the question following.

Spotty Headlines: Fill in the missing letters of each "headline," which relates to a Bible story. Then unscramble the letters you've added to the headline to form a name that is the object of the headline.

Telephone Scrambles: Each set of telephone push-buttons contains a hidden Bible word—and you'll need to determine which letter of each push-button combination is part of the word.

Word Searches: Find and circle the search words in the puzzle grid.

Answers are provided after puzzle 120. There's not much else to say, other than this: Enjoy!
