2015 ITINERARY

Day 1 & 2 – USA to the Holy Land

Your pilgrimage begins as you depart the USA on an overnight flight. You will be welcomed to the Holy Land by our airport representative and transferred to your hotel where you will enjoy dinner before retiring for the night.



Day 3 - The Galilee

This morning, pray and sing hymns as you cross the waters of the Sea of Galilee by boat. Next, travel to Capernaum, the center of Jesus' ministry. Visit the synagogue on the site where Jesus taught (Matt. 4:13, 23). At the Mount of Beatitudes read the Sermon on the Mount (Matt. 5-7). Visit the Church of the Fish and the Loaves at Tabqha, the traditional location for the feeding of the 5000 (Luke 9:10-17). Visit the **Chapel** of the Primacy where Peter professed his devotion to the risen Christ (John 21). End your day remembering Jesus' Baptism at the Jordan River.



Day 4 – Cana, Nazareth, Megiddo & Caesarea

Visit the **Franciscan** Wedding Church in Cana where Jesus perfomed his first miracle by changing water into wine (John 2). Visit Nazareth, Jesus' boyhood home (Matthew 2: 23). Overlook Tel Megiddo (Armegeddon). End your day at Caesarea, a center of the early Christians. Here is where an angel visited Cornelius, the first Gentile convert (Acts 10) and Paul was imprisoned for two years (Acts 23: 22).

Day 5 – Jericho, Qumran & the Mount of Olives

Travel to Jericho and visit the ruins of the "World's Oldest City." From this city once conquered by Joshua, (Josh. 6: 1, 2, 20) you can see the traditional site of the Temptation of Jesus (Matt. 4: 1-11). Travel to **Qumran** where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered in 1947. End your day with a group picture taken atop the Mount of Olives, where Jesus ascended into heaven (Acts 1: 9-12).



EXTENSIONS

Wonders of Jordan & Petra 3-day extension \$778*

Day 10 – Cross the Allenby Bridge into Jordan. Mount Nebo, Madaba, Amman.

Day 11 – Petra. Return to Amman for a late dinner and overnight.

Day 12 - Jerash.

Day 13 – (Sun) Depart the Holy Land for the USA.

Cairo & the Route of the Exodus 4-day extension \$798*

Day 10 – Ancient caravan route to Mount Sinai for overnight.

Day 11 – Monastery of Saint Catherine, Wadi Feiran, Elim, Marah by the Red Sea Dinner and overnight in Cairo.

Day 12 – Memphis, Sakkara, Step Pyramid. Great Pyramids of Giza, Sphinx.

Day 13 – King Tut's Treasure, Egyptian Museum, Citadel of Old Cairo, Coptic Church. Sail the Nile River aboard an authentic Egyptian Felucca.

Day 14 – (Mon) Depart Egypt and arrive in the USA.

Day 10 & 11 - Same as Cairo and the Route of the Exodus.

Day 12 – Half day tour of Cairo: Egyptian Museum, King Tut's Treasures, Great Pyramids of Giza, Sphinx. This afternoon fly to Aswan and board your Nile Cruise boat.

Day 13 – High Dam of Aswan, Granite Quarry, Unfinished Obelisk, Temple of Philae Temple of Kom Ombo.

Day 14 – Temple of Horus in Edfu. Continue via the Nile Lock to Luxor.

Day 15 – Disembark. Visit the Necropolis of Thebes, Valley of the Kings and Queens, the Temple of Hatshepsut, Colossi of Memnon, Temples of Luxor and Karnak. Fly back to Cairo for dinner and overnight.

Day 16 & 17 – (Wed/Thu) Depart Egypt and arrive in the USA.

Day 6 - Bethlehem & Jerusalem

Visit Bethlehem where the cave revered as Jesus' birthplace resides in the world's oldest functioning church (Matt. 1: 18-25). Nearby you'll see the Shepherds Fields where the Good News was first heard. View the **Herodion**. Return to Jerusalem where you will pray in the Garden of Gethsemane (Matt. 26: 36-44). Continue to Mount Zion to visit the House of the High Priest Caiaphas where Jesus was guestioned (Matt. 26: 57-65). Finally, the Last Supper comes to life as you visit the Upper Room (Mark 14: 12-26).

Day 7 - Jerusalem & the **Old City**

Take time to pray at the Western Wall. Sit on the **Teaching Steps** where Jesus once taught. Walk the Cardo, main street of the Old City. View the Pool of Bethesda where Jesus performed the Sabbath miracle (John 5: 1-31). Sing a hymn in the Church of St. Anne, known for its amazing acoustics. Visit **Herod's Antonia Fortress** where Jesus was brought before Pontius Pilate (Luke 23: 1-11). Walk the Via Dolorosa, "the Way of the Cross," and stand in reverence at the Church of the Holy Sepulchre.

Day 8 - Leisure Day (Masada/Dead Sea option) Explore on-your-own or visit Masada and the Dead Sea (additional charge). Masada was Herod's mountaintop fortress and the last stronghold of the Jewish Rebellion against the Romans. It was named a UNESCO World Heritage site in 2001. End your day with a quick dip in the salt and mineral-laden waters of the Dead Sea.

Day 9 – Jerusalem

Travel to Ein Karem, known as the birthplace of John the Baptist and the place where the Virgin Mary visited Elisabeth (Luke 1: 26-40). Visit Yad Vashem, Israel's Holocaust Memorial. Your final destination allows time for reflection at the Garden


