	A:	Because the facility experiences 24/7 usage the design of Fire Station #4 needs provide as few maintenance headaches as possible. For example, bi-fold doors may prove more cost effective for long term maintenance.		
3.	Q:	When does the City plan to have the project complete?		
	A:	April 2016.		
4.	Q:	What type of alerting system tie-in will be required?		
	A:	Gas, electric and lighting will be tied into the alerting system.		
5.	Q:	What is the timeline to award the Architectural solicitation for this project?		
	A:	The City anticipates award of the Architectural Services Agreement for Fire Station #4 one week prior to the award of this agreement.

	A:	The wastewater line that attaches to the facility may become a regional collection line. Installation of this line may become a part of the scope of work.
