Shelter Improvements in 2010

It has been another busy year at the shelter and while there are always the challenges of more animals coming to us than there are homes, we still have a lot to be thankful for. With the help of many wonderful supporters we have made a lot of improvements to the shelter this year such as:

Privacy Fence, Benches & a Storage Bldg for Play Yard all thanks to Jacob Garnett who did this for his Eagle Scout Project in support of the shelter.

Retaining Wall Project thanks to Leadership Elmore County who raised \$4300 via The Fur Ball. Construction by Cecil Malone and Brian Newton.

Parking Lot 100% graveled – funding from The Fur Ball & Shelter. Brian Newton Earthworks completed.

New & different type of Sewage Pump that finally seems to be working consistently.

Replaced 3/4's of the kennel gates in back bldg and repaired exterior fencing and gates. Funded through a \$2500 Meacham Grant (American Humane Association) and shelter funds. Completed by Birmingham Fence Co.

Painted & Sealed blocks on external kennels between our two buildings thanks to Mr. Pat Smith & Lucia Penland.
