MRI and Enhanced Digital Imaging Equipment



The impact of a Magnetic Resonance Imager (MRI) can be life changing...even life saving. From detecting cancer in virtually any part of the body to diagnosing brain and nervous system problems to imaging heart and blood vessel diseases and joint and muscle disorders, an MRI is the most effective tool to properly diagnose and treat many medical conditions.

Through the generosity of the community, the Moose Jaw Health Foundation has committed funds to bring this technology to Moose Jaw to serve patients better, faster and closer to home. It will be the first MRI permanently installed outside of Regina and Saskatoon. Along with the MRI, the hospital will also feature a new Computerized Tomography (CT) scanner and digital x-ray equipment. You can help bring this equipment to our hospital with your support of the Five Hills Health Region Employee Campaign.

Expanded Surgical Facilities

The new hospital will feature expanded surgical facilities, including an additional state-of-the-art operating room. All of the operating rooms will be located on the main floor and will feature attached surgical preparation rooms. This will improve the turnaround times between surgeries, allowing more procedures to be performed at the new regional hospital. For patients, this will mean a shorter wait for surgeries and improved recovery times. Your support will help equip each one of the four new surgical suites.

Dedicated Private Patient Rooms

The new Moose Jaw Regional Hospital will feature 72 private inpatient beds and 43 treatment rooms that are flexible and adaptable to meet the needs of patients. They will provide privacy and comfort by housing one person per room, while still allowing space for family members without impacting patient care. These rooms can be easily converted to meet the needs of different patients. Your support of the Employee Campaign will help equip many of these new rooms with patient lifts, vital signs monitors and sleeper chairs.
