One of the great benefits of time away for rest and renewal is the opportunity for the unhurried reading of scripture. Over the past week I have been reading 1 and 2 Chronicles, Ezra, and Nehemiah. Those books are not conducive to speed-reading but they are filled with rich food for our faith journey. The book of the prophet Ezra, for instance, opens by quoting an edict issued by Cyrus, king of Persia. This pagan ruler proclaims that all Jews who have been in captivity in Babylon are free to return to Israel. The Babylonian exile is over! Ezra explains how this happened by saying, "... the Lord stirred up the spirit of King Cyrus of Persia...." Even in the heart of a pagan king, God is at work through "silent stirrings."

We might each ask ourselves: Has God stirred in my heart during times of solitude? How has God spoken to me in silence? During times of solitude and silence over the past week I have experienced "silent stirrings" of gratitude for the devoted church members who have helped lead our music ministry during the past year. James Conely, Mickey McInnish, Sara Ann Turner-thank you so very much for playing the organ for our services of worship. You have truly demonstrated extravagant generosity and our church is forever grateful to you. Tom Borden has directed one of our adult handbell choirs, and I join those ringers in thanking him for his leadership of this group.
