Talent Show Expectations and Information:

- ◆ The auditions are “closed” auditions, meaning that an application is necessary to be on the audition list. Students on the audition list will be notified on Monday, February 11th of the date they are to audition on.
- ◆ Students auditioning are to come to Mrs. Coyle’s room (24) when they see After School Activities on the dismissal TV screen. Students will stay in Mrs. Coyle’s room from 4-5pm. To respect the nerves of our young artists, only the students on the audition list will be allowed in the auditions. Parents/guardians are kindly asked to come at 5pm to pick up their child. (The students will be walked to the doors at 5pm)
- ◆ Auditioning is not a guarantee to be in the Talent Show; unfortunately due to time restraints some acts may not make it into the Talent Show.
- ◆ The Talent Show cast will be notified on Monday, February 18th and be provided with a schedule of the dates and times they will practice after school. Acts who were not chosen for the Talent Show will also be notified on Monday, February 18th.
- ◆ Students will be divided into groups A and B for rehearsals with Mrs. Coyle. Rehearsals will be held on the dates listed above from after school-5pm in Mrs. Coyle’s room, 24. It is an expectation that parents/guardians will pick their child up promptly at 5pm.
- ◆ The entire cast will be expected to attend a full run-through on March 20th from after school-6pm as well as Dress Rehearsal on March 21st from after school-6pm.

- ◆ During rehearsals, students are expected to stay in the designated rooms and follow school rules.
- ◆ The Talent Show will be held on March 22nd starting at 6:30. Students in the Talent Show are asked to be at school at 5:45pm that evening. This will be a free event.
- ◆ Costumes need to be school-appropriate (no midriffs, inappropriate text on clothing, not skimpy, etc.) If you have a question, please let me know.
- ◆ If using music in your act, music also needs to be school appropriate (no references to drugs, weapons, violence, sex, illegal activity, etc.)
- ◆ As a guideline, acts should be no longer than 5 minutes.
- ◆ Each group will practice with Mrs. Coyle twice, then an additional two times during Tech Week. Please remember to practice at home so you are comfortable and confident with your act! You can do it!
