#### AMHA CLUB SHOW MAY 24, 2015

- 1. This show is approved and sanctioned by the American Miniature Horse Association, Alvarado, Texas. All horses entered must be registered by AMHA in order to show.
- 2. All senior stallions are required to present a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection for Cryptorchidism to show management prior to the show.
- 3. AMHA judge's evaluation reports will be available in the show office.
- 4. All amateur and youth MUST have a number in order to show. All amateur/youth numbers need to be sent with your entries. You may apply for and receive one at the show Manager at the show.
- 5. A protest committee reserves the right to settle and determine all questions, differences and disputes arising out of or connected with an incident to the show within the boundaries of AMHA's current rules.
- 6. All horses entered must have health papers signed by a certified vet within 30 days of the show date listing the above mentioned show.
- 7. Show will start following the SDMEC Futurity show which begins at 8:00 am sharp. Measuring will be Saturday 7pm 8 pm and Sunday morning at 7am. AMHA horses only.
- 8. Gelding status must be noted on the horse's registration papers in order to show
- 9. Stalls will be available from Noon Friday the 22Nd and must be vacated by 10:00 pm on Sunday. Anyone who wishes to arrive earlier or stay late must contact the Fairgrounds directly. Stalls will be \$40.00 for the weekend. Shavings will be \$6.50 per bag. All bedding MUST be purchased with your entries, NOEXCEPTIONS. All horses must have a stall. NO JUMP OUTS. NO nails/staples can be used on the stalls. \*\*When entering, you must fill out fees schedule for each show, but stalls are one price for the weekend. You can fill out fees schedule for stalls on one but do not need to on the other.
- 10. All dogs must be on a leash at all times.
- 11. NO SMOKING is allowed within the confines of the barns or within the Show Arena.
- 12. Parking: There are designated parking areas. After unloading vehicles and trailers, they must park in the designated area. No parking on the grass, near trash removal areas, near fire exits, main drive or directly north of the facility.
- 13. RV's: Parking for RV's is available for \$50.00 each for the weekend. Please note on your entry form how many spaces are needed. A parking permit will be required and will be issued by the show office.
- 14. Concessions: On the show grounds.
- 15. NO PAINTING OF HOOFS ON CEMENT FLOORS. You must use something under their feet so as not to leave hoof black on the floor.

- 16. Awards: Ribbons 1<sup>st</sup> 6<sup>th</sup> place. Small neck ribbons for Champion classes. Classic neck ribbons for Champion of Champion.
- 17. Directions to the Sioux Empire Fairgrounds. From I 90 take I 29 south to Exit 80. Go east into fairgrounds. Expo building is at South end of fairgrounds.
- 18. Hotels within 5 miles of the fairgrounds: Brimark Inn 3200 W. Russell St. (800)658-4508. Ramada Limited 405 S. Lyons off 12<sup>th</sup> across from the fairgrounds (605)330-0000. Oaks Hotel 3300 Russell St. (605-336-9000).
- 19. All Adds & Scratches MUST be made at least four classes previous and must have an Add & Scratch slip made out with the show management.
- 20. All Tack Changes must be made to the gate person or the show management at least two classes ahead.
- 21. The two minute gate call will be enforced. Class announcements to the barns are a courtesy. It is the responsibility of the exhibitors to be on time for classes.
- 22. A Pee Wee Novice Class (non-sanctioned and free) for youth will be offered at 11AM. All youth are welcome to participate, regardless of age or experience.

Entries must be postmarked by May 10<sup>th</sup>, 2015. Entries must include a copy of the horse's registration papers, and a copy of current Youth and Amateur cards.
