I have received the results of your Pap smear which showed an abnormality known as atypia. I want to reassure you that there is no evidence of malignancy. A second test was performed to see if the human papillomavirus (HPV) was present, and this test came back negative. This is most reassuring.

Given that no HPV was found, most likely the changes seen on your Pap smear are of a benign nature. I would recommend a follow up Pap smear in one year. I want to reassure you that this recommendations is based on guidelines developed by experts in Pap smear/HPV abnormalities and that your findings are being managed in the appropriate manner.
