Citrus shipped under a Repacking Certificate of Privilege will meet the following requirements: (a) the applicable minimum grade and size requirements under Marketing Order No. 905; (b) all fruit shall have been inspected by the Federal or Federal State Inspection Service prior to the time such fruit is received; (c) All citrus fruit handled shall be packed in approved Florida Department of Citrus containers (d) be reported to the Committee as required in Section 905.163, Reports of Shipments under Repacking Certificate of Privilege.
