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Expectations

Math 8 is an exploration of mathematical concepts such as Functions, Irrational Numbers and the Pythagorean Theorem. Expect me to help guide you in understanding as I expect you to come to class ready to engage yourself in the learning process.

The Goal is to Master the 8th Grade Core Standards. On each assessment, you will receive personalized feedback, which, if followed, will help your understanding of the specific standard develop.

Portfolio - Essential Standard Tracker

Each student will have a portfolio—a portfolio that will be used to collect evidence of Standard Mastery. We will routinely (as student/teacher duo) go through your portfolio and discuss how we can help you achieve mastery. In the Portfolio will also be an Essential Standard Tracker (a copy of which you will be receiving to take home). This Tracker is a calendar, record-keeper, and a list of resources. It will help you be organized as we start working through the 8th Grade Curriculum.

Notes and Problem Set Packets

For each Unit, we will work through a Packet. In this packet, there will be notes, activities and problem sets. The problem sets should be completed daily to practice what we are learning in class. These packets are your first mode of defense in mastering the standards. At the back of these packets, there will also be a list of Khan Academy activities that will help you grow confident in the skills we learn.

Khan Academy

Khan Academy is an online program that is set up to help students learn and master mathematical content. There are tutorials and practice sets. This program will be used routinely in class to remediate and to solidify understanding. Working through the 8th Grade Mission at home is a great way to help you better understand the concepts we are learning in class. This is also a great resource for parents who would like a refresher course in 8th Grade Math—your parent can create their own account and learn themselves.
