"Door County Wisconsin" CARAVAN U-402 September 8-18, 2012 GREATER ST. LOUIS MO WBCCI UNIT

Caravan will camp on the Door County Peninsular in Wisconsin for 6 nights with full hook-ups. With 10 registrations, Caravan will be an officially numbered WBCCI caravan with kitty fee operation. Caravan rendezvous near <u>Rockford, Illinois</u>, with 3 interesting stops to Door County. Door County itself is a peninsula surrounded by Lake Michigan and is only 70 miles in length and 10 miles at its widest point. It boasts 10 lighthouses, pristine scenery, performing arts, galleries, unique shops and quaint harbor side communities.

Sept 8 Rendezvous Site with Dinner near Rockford, Illinois

Sept 9 Oshkosh, Wisconsin. Relaxing at this lakeside community.

Sept 10 Greenbush, Wisconsin A full day to visit the 1850 Wade House (a three story southern mansion look) Stagecoach Inn. We will take a wagon ride to explore the grounds which include a sawmill, blacksmith shop and Carriage Museum (with nearly 100 horse drawn and hand drawn carriages, sleighs, wagons, etc.). While here, under the tutelage of a culinary chef, Airstreamers will cook a hearthside dinner of a bygone era in the kitchen of the stagecoach inn. After the cooking is complete, we will sit down in the Wade House dining room to enjoy our prepared delicious and abundant dinner.

Sept 11 Kewaunee, Wisconsin Visiting this lakeside resort and lighthouse.

Sept 12-17 Egg Harbor, WI 6 nights in one campground in the middle of Door County. Group boat ride to Washington Island for a narrated Trolley tour. Later, a photo-op boat tour of off shore lighthouses. Short drives from campground to visit lighthouses, restaurants, museums, marinas, fishing, shops, beaches, parks, etc.
