- We do expect parents to support the school uniform policy and will bring to your attention incorrect items.
- \$\frac{\psi}{\text{Short skirts and high heels are not acceptable and should be kept for out of school. Skirts should sit just above/below the knee, and no boots.
- KS2 Pupils should have an old large shirt/T-shirt for art and craft activities.
- † Parents will be informed by letter if a pupil regularly forgets their P.E. kit.
- Reception and Y1&2, jewellery, ear-rings, bracelets etc. are **not** allowed at school as serious accidents have occurred in some schools when these have been worn.
- † Y3, 4, 5 & 6, children are permitted to wear a watch and plain stud earrings only. If earrings are worn they must be removed (by the child) for P.E. lessons.
