- 5. Must be at least 18 years of age.
- 6. You must complete the attached *<u>handwritten</u>* essay.
- 7. You must meet the minimum physical standards required for the profession of EMT-Paramedic. You will need to be able to:

Frequently lift and carry objects weighing 125 pounds or more.

Must be able to stand, climb, balance, stoop, kneel, crouch, or crawl for extended periods of time and / or on uneven terrain. Hear audible sounds.

Grasp and hold objects for an extended period of time.

Good motor coordination (coordinate hand – eye movement).

Withstand varied environmental conditions.

Should possess excellent communication skills

- 9. Must have a valid Drivers License
- 10. You must complete the Adult Basic Learning Examination at a 10th grade level or higher in all areas. (Exam to be provided by MGHS)
- 11. You must successfully complete a physical agility test, hearing & vision test. (Testing will be provided by MGHS)
- 12. Two (2) letters of reference; At least one from an active Paramedic.
- 13. The Applicant <u>must provide proof</u> of the following immunizations; (must submit with application) Hepatitis B series (HBV), HBV series must be started, or completed prior to the first night of class) Current TB test (with-in 1 year)
