Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

How?	All financial companies need to share members' personal information to run their everyday business. What We Do				
How does Country Federal Credit Union Protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings. We also maintain other physical, electronic, and procedural safeguards to protect this information and we limit access to information to those employees for whom access is appropriate.			
How does Country Federal Credit Union collect my personal information?	 We collect your personal information, for example, when you Open an account Make a wire transfer Apply for a loan Show your driver's license Make deposits or withdrawals from your account We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, and other companies. 			
Why can't I limit all sharing?	 Federal law gives you the right to limit only sharing for affiliate's everyday business purposes – information about your credit worthiness affiliates from using your information to market to you sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing. 			
What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?	Your choice will apply to everyone on your account.

Definitions	
Affiliates	 Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies. <i>Country Federal Credit Union has no affiliates</i>
Nonaffiliates	 Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies. Nonaffiliates we share with can include Insurance companies
Joint Marketing	 A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. Our joint marketing partners include Credit Card companies
