VISITING THE WOMEN'S CENTER

We have set up our visiting guidelines in order to provide the best care possible, protect the privacy of our patients, and ensure that you and your family are able to enjoy your special day.

Visiting Hours: Our Women's Center visitation hours are from 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m.

Birth Room: Visitors are allowed prior to delivery. For delivery, we ask that no more than two visitors be in the room.

Hallways: For safety reasons, it is important that visitors do not congregate in the hallways. There is a waiting room available.

Recovery: Following delivery, mom will generally need a minimum of one hour to recover and bond with her new baby. Following this recovery period, visitors will be allowed to return upon mom's request.

Siblings: Siblings are encouraged to meet their new brother or sister. However, children under the age of 12 that are not siblings are not permitted to visit.

Cafeteria: The Spice of Life Café is located on the first floor, near the main entrance. Hours are Monday through Friday from 7:00 a.m. until 9:00 p.m. and weekends from 7:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m.

Gift Shop: The Gift Shop is located on the first floor near the elevators. Hours are Monday through Friday from 10:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m.

Internet Access: Complimentary wireless access is available throughout the hospital.
