#### What is APL?

### Accreditation of Prior Learning (APL) Guidelines

#### PLATFORM ACCREDITATION SCHEME (PAS)

The APL application form for PAS(d) has to be submitted together with the separate APL application form for PAS(s).

The APL application form for PAS(s) can be submitted without applying for PAS(d)

# An applicant for APL must be either (i) a full member of an SNU affiliated church/centre, (ii) an Individual Member of the SNU or (iii) a Member of SNU International.

Accreditation of **P**rior Learning is for people who want to work towards achieving an SNU award and have already gained a vast amount of knowledge and experience in demonstrations of speaking and demonstrating and/or attending or running workshops on these subjects. This is known as 'experiential learning'.

**APL** recognises 'experiential learning' already achieved and when applying for APL the candidate has to provide supporting evidence in the form of witness statements, and other documentation to support their application including photocopy evidence of course SD1 completion letter.

The first route towards achieving an SNU award in speaking and demonstrating or speaking is to register and complete the Platform Accreditation Scheme (PAS) criteria in (a) speaking or (b) speaking and demonstrating.

The experiential learning applicant must complete individual APL applications for each subject in accordance with the following guidelines:

- (1) APL application form for PAS(s) can be submitted without completing a separate APL application form for PAS(d).
- (2) APL application form for PAS(d) has to be submitted together with a separate APL application form for PAS(s).

**APL Speaking** Complete APL application form for speaking. Witness statements and supporting evidence of knowledge and experience must be submitted with the application form plus photocopy evidence of course SD1 completion letter and £30 fee.

**APL Demonstrating** Complete APL application form for demonstrating. Witness statements and supporting evidence of knowledge and experience must be submitted with the application form plus photocopy evidence of course SD1 completion letter and £30 APL fee. **APL demonstrating application must be accompanied by APL speaking application.** 

If the APL application is successful in either one or both subjects, the applicant's skills and abilities are recognised by waving specific criteria associated with the PAS(s) and PAS(d).

**Waving of PAS Criteria** The waving of PAS criteria in speaking and speaking/demonstrating includes not having to (i) take 25 church services and have log books signed each time by the chairperson, (ii) attend and pay for the review sessions in each subject and (iii) wait to complete these criteria and instead go straight for the Final Assessment in PAS (s)(d) or PAS(s) Final. (Evidence of completion of SD1 course is required).

**CSNU Award** Successful APL PAS candidates who at their Final Assessment want to be considered for a CSNU award have to comply and agree to the following conditions:

- (a) has successfully completed Courses SD1 and SD4
- (b) is an individual member of the SNU
- (c) agrees when registering to pay the extra cost for each subject
- (d) agrees to take the higher level CSNU (s)(d) or CSNU(s) Final Assessment criteria
- (e) accepts the decision of assessors on whether or not they have achieved CSNU standard, PAS standard or failed to achieve either standard for an award to be granted.

#### **Collecting Evidence**

To support a claim for APL the experiential learning applicant must gather evidence for a portfolio. The evidence collected must be appropriate and genuine and should include:

- Witness testimonies people qualified to act as witnesses and confirm accuracy of candidate's capabilities, skills and experience.
- Witness testimonies of workshops, seminars and courses attended
- Observations where someone will see you performing certain things
- Certificates photocopy evidence of relevant certificates
- · Letters of completion for SNU and other education courses

#### **Application Payment Fee**

At the time of notifying Registrations it will be necessary to pay the application fees. Evidence of paying the fees must be submitted with the completed APL application form.

The completed APL application form, evidence gathered in portfolio and evidence of payment of fees should be sent to: Minister June English, Chairman of Accreditation either electronically at acc.dir@snu.org.uk or addressed to 2B Sheppard Road, Balby, Doncaster.

#### **Independent Assessors**

The completed APL application form and evidence gathered in a portfolio with be assessed by 3 independent Assessors and their recommendation made to T&A, who will make the final decision.

#### **Certificate of Competence**

Successful APL applicants will be issued with a letter confirming the APL has been approved.

Candidates who fulfil all relevant criteria, have completed necessary courses/s and achieved the necessary points are eligible to forego the training required for the award and go straight to a Final Assessment.

Guidance notes below on the primary assessment criteria for speaking and demonstrating

#### Speaking - Primary assessment criteria

The talk at all levels should be uplifting, inspiring, motivating and based on SNU philosophy. It may contain elements of history, which should not be the biggest part of the address. Personal experiences can be included but only to make a pertinent point.

#### **Demonstrating - Primary assessment criteria**

To provide evidence beyond reasonable doubt of one spirit communicator to two recipients by providing a body of information that pertains to the communicator. It should be uplifting or bring comfort to the bereaved. The demonstration should be of a higher standard with each higher level of award.
