- Speak at an ACS event, as a college scholarship recipient
- Volunteer to be an ACS R.O.C.K.(Reaching Out to Cancer Kids) Camp Counselor at Camp Boggy Creek
- Volunteer for Families R.O.C.K. (Reaching Out to Cancer Kids) Weekend
- Do office work / stuff envelopes at your local ACS Unit Office
- Many more opportunities
