DIRECT DEPOSIT ENROLLMENT FOR LOAN GUARANTY PROGRAM PARTICIPANTS

- 1. **PURPOSE.** The purpose of this circular is to establish a campaign to publicize the U.S. Treasury's requirement that vendors enroll in the Direct Deposit Program.
- 2. **BACKGROUND.** Beginning January 2, 1999, the Debt Collection Improvement Act of 1996 requires Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) as the primary medium of federal payments for claims and services. Currently, Loan Guaranty program participant enrollment in EFT is only about 15% nationwide. While Treasury did not establish a percentile goal or requirement for enrollment, agencies are required to make every effort to comply with the Act. It is expected that this one time campaign will improve VBA's compliance. Increasing the enrollment will benefit the government by reducing the cost of doing business. As a result of the elimination of mail time and a reduction in processing time, vendors that sign up for direct deposit may expect payment 3 to 7 days sooner than vendors who are not enrolled.
- 3. <u>ACTION.</u> In order to comply with Treasury's direct deposit requirements, stations will notify program participants of the Direct Deposit Program as follows:
- a. Establish the sample direct deposit enrollment form (exhibit A) as a local form. When preparing as a local form, delete the header/footer (VBA, circular, and exhibit information) and include the regional office number, a local contact, and the contact's phone number. Stations may place the locally designated form on a VA (station) web-site in order to provide program participants the option of downloading it directly from the Internet.
- b. Stations will prepare a notification for immediate release to all current program participants and provide the release to new participants on an on-going basis. Include a copy of the locally designated direct deposit enrollment form with the release. A sample release is attached as Exhibit B. Copies of these releases need not be submitted to Central Office. Although enrollment will be on-going, stations should make a concerted effort through July 31, 2001, to make program participants aware of the Direct Deposit Program and to encourage their participation. Program participants will submit their completed enrollment forms to their financial institutions. The financial institution will forward the forms directly to VA's Financial Services Center (FSC) at the address shown on the enrollment form.

SUBJ: Direct Deposit Enrollment for Loan Guaranty Program Participants

1. <u>U.S. TREASURY REQUIRES DIRECT DEPOSIT</u>. The U.S. Treasury requires that government agencies enroll vendors in the Direct Deposit Program.

Beginning January 2, 1999, the Debt Collection Improvement Act of 1996 requires Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) as the primary medium of federal payments for claims and services. Currently, Loan Guaranty program participant enrollment in EFT is about 15% nationwide. Direct deposit is highly recommended as a way to expedite receipt of payments from VA.

⇒ **FASTER PAYMENT**. Vendors that sign up for direct deposit may expect to receive payment 3 to 7 business days sooner than vendors that do not sign up.

- ⇒ Sign up for direct deposit by July 31, 2001.
- ⇒ Complete the individual or company information portion of the enclosed direct deposit enrollment form (*Note to Stations Include the Locally Designated Form Number here*) and submit it to your financial institution.
