Dear Mr. Dogic:

Alston & Bird is pleased to provide government relations, communications, and strategic advisory services to Mims. The purpose of this letter is to confirm the terms of our overall engagement. You are engaging us to help you and people identified by you to promote Mim's business interests, trade, investment, and bilateral relations between Bosnia and Herzegovina and the United States. You have advised that it is important for key decisions-makers and opinion-makers in the United States to be aware about developments in Bosnia and Herzegovina and to recognize Bosnia and Herzegovina as an ally, a stable democracy, and a valued trading partner. You have further advised that the ability of decision-makers and opinion-makers in the United States to appreciate properly Bosnia and Herzegovina's policies and achievements requires that they have a detailed, correct, and balanced understanding of various issues in Bosnia and Herzegovina and the Balkan region, including the governmental process, politics, and the economy.

This engagement will be effective May 1, 2009, and will continue in effect until October 31, 2009, unless otherwise agreed by Alston & Bird and Mims. During our engagement, you agree to pay Alston & Bird a monthly retainer of \$20,000. Throughout the period of this engagement, we will issue monthly statements for our services rendered in the previous month, payment due upon receipt.
