Musicians Institute offers the MI Development Scholarship in order to encourage the educational development of musicians and music industry professionals.

The scholarship requirements and details are as follows:

- Available to U.S. citizens and permanent residents only.
- Applicant must be entering the program for the first time.
- Complete applications must be received by scholarship due date. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- Based on demonstrated financial need as well as academic history.
- May be applied to any Musicians Institute Certificate or Degree program (MI Select and Select Express are not eligible).
- The total scholarship amount will be divided by the total number of quarters in the particular program and credited toward each quarter's tuition in equal amounts for as long as the student maintains satisfactory academic progress.
- Scholarships are non-transferable, and may not be applied to any person, program, or start date other than the one for which it was originally awarded.

Eligibility

To be eligible for the MI Development Scholarship:

- Applicant must be accepted into a qualified program.
- Applicant must have completed federal financial aid application by the appropriate due date.

Depending on the volume of applications received, award recipients will be notified from one to three weeks following the application due date.

Application Deadline

For eligible programs beginning: Winter 2016 Deadline is: November 30, 2015

For eligible programs beginning: Spring 2016

Deadline is: December 7, 2015
