Prequalification is a primary component for owners to define project specific needs and choose the right team for their Traditional and Alternative Delivery project. A well qualified partner can provide the right expertise, resources and financial stability for successful completion and avoid delays and cost overruns.

- Based on state contracting law, size, complexity, schedule and financial capacity: Defining the type
 of delivery system that is best for your project (design-build, CM at Risk, design-bid-build)
- Prequalification of Teams Criteria:
