"Upon completing the internship, each student must submit a report on the work carried out to his or her internship evaluation committee, composed of the student's academic advisor, two other faculty members, and (optionally) a representative of the organization at which the internship took place. The committee will evaluate the student's work and assign a grade for the internship credits. The external member from the internship organization, if any, may assist in the evaluation process but has no authority in assigning the final grade.

Upon receiving a passing grade by the internship committee, the student will be awarded one non-GPA credit for every 4 weeks of full-time work. Students may earn up to 6 non-GPA credits for internships during their studies in the undergraduate program. Every undergraduate degree at AIT requires at least 3 internship credits to satisfy graduation requirements."
