What is Title I?

Hickory Hills Elementary School is identified as a Title I school as part of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 (ESEA). Title I programs must be based on effective means of improving student achievement and include strategies to support parental involvement. All Title I schools must jointly develop with all parents a written parental involvement policy.

School Plan for Shared Student Achievement

What is it? This is a plan that describes how Hickory Hills Elementary School will provide opportunities to improve parent engagement to support student learning. Hickory Hills values the contributions and involvement of parents in order to establish an equal partnership for the common goal of improving student achievement. Hickory Hills Elementary will provide full opportunity for the participation of parents with limited English, parents with disabilities and parents of migratory children.

Where is it available? At the beginning of the year, the plan is included in the student handbook that is given to all students. As a reminder, we will review the plan during our annual Open House event and provide parents with a copy during fall parent-teacher conferences. Parents can also retrieve a copy of the plan in the Parent Resource Center.
