<u>What is the Rocky Mountain Pavement Preservation Partnership (RMPPP)?</u>

The Rocky Mountain Pavement Preservation Partnership is a regional forum comprised of pavement professionals from State and Provincial Agencies, Contractors, Suppliers, Academia, and Local and Federal Government Officials, all working together to take advantage of the synergy to be gained from sharing information and identifying common issues for further investigation. The gathering provides a forum to share and publicize improvements in research, design, specifications, materials and construction practices, and to promote the benefits of Pavement Preservation through education and application.

When and where will the Partnership Meeting be held?

Membership Benefits in the RMPPP

You are encouraged to become a member of the RMPPP, but membership is not required. Below is an explanation of membership guidelines and costs, as well as non-member prices.

<u>State and Provincial membership</u> includes travel and registration reimbursements for two voting participants who will also be eligible to serve as officers.

Local and Federal Government Officials and Academic membership is included with paid registration fees at the rate of \$200 per person. You will also be eligible to serve as an officer and have one vote on issues being considered at the business meeting.

<u>Industry membership</u> includes one paid exhibitor display space, paid registration for two participants who will also be eligible to serve as officers, and one vote on issues being considered at the business meeting.

Member organizations may register additional participants for \$200 / person.

Non-member organizations may register participants at \$350 / person and purchase one exhibitor space for \$700.
