- Purpose: -To recognize two outstanding graduating high school seniors for achievements.
- To provide financial assistance to aid seniors in accomplishing their future financial management baccalaureate educational goals.
- Scholarship Award: -Two scholarship awards for \$1,500.00 each.
- Recognition at an ASMC Mile High Chapter luncheon meeting, attendance is highly encouraged.
- Nomination Procedure: -Nominations are to be made by the high school counselor with no more than two per school. Selection will be made by the ASMC Mile High Scholarship Awards Committee.
- Scholarship Procedure: -Nominations must be submitted using ASMC Scholarship Forms Student Biography, Nomination Form, and essay.
- Nominee must be an outstanding graduating Colorado high school senior.
 - Nominee must be entering a field of study directly related to financial management (accounting, finance, business administration, economics, public administration, computer science, or operations research related to financial management).
 - Nominee must have two letters of recommendation, at least one of which from an academic official.
 - Nominee's scholastic achievements, leadership ability, extracurricular activities, and career goals will be considered, and must be completely documented in the letters of recommendation, biography, and essay.
 - Nominee must attach a copy of their high school transcript(s).
 - Nominee must attach a copy of their ACT or SAT score.
 - Nominee must attach proof of enrollment or acceptance letter if not yet available.
- Deadline: -All nominations must be received no later than March 1, 2012.
- Note: -In the absence of suitable nominees, ASMC reserves the right to withhold award(s).
