

Concurrent Enrollment Options Agreement and Registration Form

You have indicated that you are interested in enrolling in one or more college course(s) while a high school student. The State of Colorado provides several options for high school students who meet high school standards to begin college prior to graduating high school. The purposes of these options include promoting content standards, providing academic challenges and providing access to academic courses that may not be available at a local high school to meet high school graduation requirements. MSU Denver offers three concurrent enrollment options for high school students who meet the requirements and are approved by their high school counselor or principal.

CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT OPTIONS at MSU Denver:

- ASCENT. The 5th year ASCENT program allows you to take a full schedule of college course work immediately following your senior year of high school. High school students under twenty-one years of age, who have met all district's graduation requirements, have completed 12 college credit hours, and do not need remediation are eligible for this program. To enroll at an eligible post-secondary institution a student must have completed the minimum course prerequisites and all required assessments.
- CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT. High school students under twenty-one years of age, enrolled in the 9th 12th grade in a school district, who demonstrate academic preparedness, are eligible for the concurrent enrollment program. Students enrolled in 12th grade at a school district may enroll in remedial courses, if approved by the school district. If a high school student is retained for instructional purposes in the 12th grade, they may not enroll in more than 9 credits concurrently during the repeat year. To enroll at an eligible post-secondary institution a student must have completed the minimum course prerequisites and all required assessments.
- STUDENT EDUCATION & ENRICHMENT (SEE). High school students 16 years or older may enroll in college courses at MSU Denver as a non-degree-seeking students under the SEE Program. To enroll at an eligible post-secondary institution a student must have completed the minimum course prerequisites and all required assessments. These enrollments are not state-funded under the School Finance Act. The student is not entitled to tuition reimbursement by the school district. Home-schooled students may participate in the SEE Program.

- I will meet the same course expectations and prerequisites as college students, as noted in the course catalog and/or syllabus.
- The course satisfies college degree, certificate and/or remedial education requirements and is in line with the students ICAP.
- Course credits may transfer if I earn a C or better in a Guarantee transfer course, or accepted by a post-secondary
- The grade received in this course will appear on my official high school and college transcript.
- If I withdraw from the course at the postsecondary institution after the drop/add date, I will receive a W or F on my college transcript.
- With regard to college activities, qualified students may participate in activities but are not eligible for NCAA athletic activities.
- I will need to register for College Opportunity Funding and I understand the credits earned will be deducted from the COF lifetime account, at institutions which receive COF funding.
- ✓ I understand I may only enroll in Guarantee transfer courses and/or courses which apply to a specific pathway.

ASCENT ONLY:

- I understand the school district will hold my high school diploma and not count me as a graduate until I have completed the ASCENT Program.
- Students who wish to enroll in college classes the summer immediately following their senior year must pay their own tuition.
