GROUND TRANSPORTATION

The InterContinental Wellington Hotel is approximately 8 kilometers from Wellington International Airport and the ride takes about 20-30 minutes, depending on traffic. The hotel can arrange taxi service in advance of arrival and departure at a flat rate of \$55 NZD (approximately \$47 USD) for international arrivals; \$40 NZD (approximately \$34 USD) for international departures. PASSPORT/VISA INFORMATION

All visitors to New Zealand must carry a passport that is valid for at least three months beyond the date you intend to leave the country. Travelers are required to show an onward or return ticket to a country that you have permission to enter. U.S. citizens do not need a visa to enter or transit New Zealand.
