# 7.1 Excellence in Education: Manitouwadge PS: Expanding Our Minds to Reach Our Goals

Acting Principal Shari Kingston provided a detailed report about how the mathematic curriculum is approached with students; the emphasis being on the value of the process of math thinking, not just the answer. She explained how a number of programs and tools are used to instill a growth mindset in children. Ultimately the goal is to help children learn but to do so in an environment where the instruction does not leave students anxious but rather excited to realize how numbers talk.

Student Council President Brooklyn Nemeth and Vice-President Ethan Shearer each provided a report about student life at Manitouwadge Public School. They outlined the many projects and events that the Student Council is involved with and provided numerous examples of relationship building among and throughout the school.

#### 7.2 Student Trustee Cassidy Houston

C. Houston provided a detailed report on the recent events at all the area schools. Neurodiversity Day events took place at many of the schools on April 16<sup>th</sup>. A number of schools incorporated bullying awareness activities to help focus on the acceptable behaviours, and recognizing that differences among students need to be celebrated. C. Houston made note of the how students are quite happy with the addition of Wi-Fi in the schools. It has made a real difference and students welcome the opportunity to work on their laptops throughout the school, even the cafeteria.

9.1 Report No. 28: Enrolment Summary for 2014/2015 as of March 31, 2015

Superintendent of Business Cathy Tsubouchi provided an overview of the report noting that overall, enrolment as of the March 31 ministry count date is up 17.60 FTE from budget.

9.2 Report No. 29: Enrolment Projection for 2015-2016

In reviewing this report, C. Tsubouchi noted that for 2015-2016 school year, projections indicate an overall decrease in enrolment of 39.10 ADE (Average Daily Enrolment) from this year.

- 9.3 Report No. 30: Grant for Student Needs 2015-2016
  - C. Tsubouchi reported on the Ministry of Education March 26, 2015 release of the Grants for Student Needs (2015-16). She outlined various components included in the funding model, noting that the ministries School Board Efficiencies and Modernization phase-in program have impacted several of the grants. In addition Declining enrolment and excess capacity continue to create budget pressures. The Ministry's deadline for submission of the 2015/16 budget is June 30, 2015.
